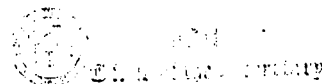





AN ACT SEPARATING THE POLO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL -
MALANDAY ANNEX IN BARANGAY MALANDAY,
VALENZUELA CITY FROM THE POLO NATIONAL
HIGH SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN
INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE
KNOWN AS MALANDAY NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL,
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Polo National High School - Malanday
2 Annex in Barangay Malanday, Valenzuela City is hereby separated
3 from the Polo National High School and converted into an
4 independent national high school to be known as Malanday
5 National High School.

6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the
7 Polo National High School - Malanday Annex are hereby
8 transferred to and absorbed by the Malanday National High School.

1 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include
2 in the Department's program the operationalization of the
3 Malanday National High School, the initial funding of which shall
4 be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Polo
5 National High School - Malanday Annex. Thereafter, the amount
6 necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included
7 in the annual General Appropriations Act.

8 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules
9 and regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act
10 within one hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

11 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
12 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
13 circulation.
