
MR. PRESIDENT:



AN ACT DECLARING DECEMBER 8 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF AGOO,
PROVINCE OF LA UNION, TO BE KNOWN AS "AGOO DAY"

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. December 8 of every year is hereby declared a special
2 nonworking holiday in the Municipality of Agoo, Province of La Union, in
3 commemoration of its founding anniversary, to be known as "Agoo Day".

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
5 in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
