ANNIVERSARY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. July 4 of every year is hereby declared a
2 special nonworking holiday in the City of Cadiz, Province of
3 Negros Occidental, in commemoration of its charter day
4 anniversary.

5 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following
6 the completion of its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a
7 newspaper of general circulation.
