

AN ACT DECLARING SEPTEMBER 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF BAGUIO,
PROVINCE OF BENGUET, IN COMMEMORATION OF THE
SURRENDER OF THE JAPANESE MILITARY FORCES LED BY
GENERAL TOMOYUKI YAMASHITA IN BAGUIO CITY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. September 3 of every year is hereby declared a special
2 nonworking holiday in the City of Baguio, Province of Benguet, in
3 commemoration of the surrender of the Japanese military forces led by
4 General Tomoyuki Yamashita at the American High Commissioner's
5 Residence in Camp John Hay, Baguio City.

6 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
7 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
