Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:									
SECTION 1. The San Lorenzo Ruiz Women's Hospital in									
Malabon City, Metro Manila is hereby converted into a genera									
hospital to be known as the San Lorenzo Ruiz General Hospital.									
SEC. 2. The authorized bed capacity of the San Lorenzo Rui									
General Hospital in Malabon City, Metro Manila is hereby									
increased from ten (10) to two hundred (200) beds.									
SEC. 3. The existing professional health care services									
facilities and health human resource of the San Lorenzo Ruiz									
General Hospital are hereby upgraded to conform and be									
commensurate to the increase in its authorized bed capacity a

SEC. 4. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

8 SEC. 5. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, 9 the Secretary of Health shall, in consultation with the Secretary of 10 Budget and Management, promulgate the necessary rules and 11 regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

12 SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its 13 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general 14 circulation.
