AN ACT CREATING TWO (2) ADDITIONAL BRANCHES OF THE REGIONAL TRIAL COURT AND ONE (1) ADDITIONAL BRANCH OF THE MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURT IN CITIES IN THE FOURTH JUDICIAL REGION. TO  $\mathbf{BE}$ STATIONED IN THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA. PROVINCE OF LAGUNA. AND APPROPRIATING **FUNDS** THEREFOR. AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 14(E) AND SECTION 29 OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129. OTHERWISE "THE KNOWN AS JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980", AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Two (2) additional branches of the Regional Trial
- 2 Court and one (1) additional branch of the Municipal Trial Court in
- 3 Cities, to be stationed in the City of Santa Rosa, Province of
- 4 Laguna, are hereby created in the Fourth Judicial Region.

The	Supreme	Court	shall	assign	$\mathbf{the}$	respective	branch
numbers for the newly created branches of the Regional Trial Court							
and Mun	icipal Trial	Court	in Cit	ies.			

SEC. 2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with the Secretary of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the Court's program the operationalization of two (2) additional branches of the Regional Trial Court and one (1) additional branch of the Municipal Trial Court in Cities, to be stationed in the City of Santa Rosa, Province of Laguna, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. Section 14(e) and Section 29 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise known as "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended, and all other laws, rules and regulations which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
