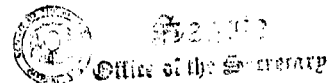

have considered the same and have the honor to report back to the Senate with the recommendation that the attached House Bill No. 5880, be approved with one amendment, to wit:


1. On Page 1, after line 8, insert a new section that shall read as follows:



AN ACT UPGRADING THE AMAI PAKPAK MEDICAL CENTER IN MARAWI CITY, PROVINCE OF LANA DEL SUR AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The bed capacity of the Amai Pakpak Medical Center in
2 Marawi City, Province of Lanao del Sur is hereby increased from two hundred
3 (200) to four hundred (400) beds.

4 SEC. 2. The existing hospital facilities and professional health care
5 services of the Amai Pakpak Medical Center are hereby upgraded and
6 increased to conform with and be commensurate to the increase in bed
7 capacity. The number of medical personnel shall be correspondingly
8 increased.

1 SEC. 3. The construction and upgrading of the hospital facilities and
2 services shall be under the direct supervision and control of the Department of
3 Health.

4 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the
5 Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which
6 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

7 SEC. 5. Republic Act No. 7943 is hereby repealed.

8 SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
9 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
