AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE FOR SOCIAL WELFARE ATTACHÉ, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8042, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "MIGRANT WORKERS AND OVERSEAS FILIPINOS ACT OF 1995", AS AMENDED, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 2, paragraph (b) of Republic Act

No. 8042, as amended, is hereby amended to read as

follows:

"(b) The State shall afford full protection

to labor, local and overseas, organized and

unorganized, and promote full employment and

equality of employment opportunities for all.

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1	Towards this end, the State shall provide
2	adequate and timely social, economic and legal
3	services to Filipino migrant workers[.],
4	ESPECIALLY SINCE THESE WORKERS
5	ARE VULNERABLE TO EXTREME
6	PHYSICAL, EMOTIONAL AND

8	SEC. 2. A new paragraph (e) is hereby inserted in
9	Section 23 of Republic Act No. 8042, as amended, to read
10	as follows:
11	"(E) DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL
12	WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT - THE
13	DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND
14	DEVELOPMENT SHALL DEPLOY SOCIAL
15	WELFARE ATTACHÉS TO MANAGE CASES
16	OF OVERSEAS FILIPINO WORKERS
17	NEEDING PSYCHOSOCIAL SERVICES AND
18	OVERSEAS FILIPINOS IN DISTRESS, SUCH
19	AS VICTIMS OF TRAFFICKING, ILLEGAL
20	RECRUITMENT, SEXUALLY-ABUSED,

1	MALTREATED/MISTREATED OVERSEAS
2	FILIPINOS, ABANDONED/NEGLECTED
3	CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE SECTORS
4	IN COORDINATION WITH THE MEMBERS

8	SEC. 3. Funding The amount necessary to carry out
9	the provisions of this Act shall be provided for in the
10	General Appropriations Act of the year following its
11	enactment into law and thereafter.
12	SEC. 4. Implementing Rules and Regulations. – The
13	Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD),
14	in consultation with the Department of Foreign Affairs,
15	Department of Labor and Employment, Department of
16	Health, Philippine Overseas Employment Administration,
17	Overseas Workers Welfare Administration, Commission on
18	Filipino Overseas and other relevant stakeholders, shall
19	formulate and issue the implementing rules and
20	regulations for this Act within sixty (60) days after the

- effectivity of this Act. The DSWD shall also provide the criteria for determining the selection of Diplomatic Posts to which Social Welfare Attachés will be deployed and the minimum qualifications and attributes of the Social
- 6 SEC. 5. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any 7 section or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional 8 or invalid, other sections or provisions hereof shall remain 9 in force.
- SEC. 6. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules, regulations or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- 14 SEC. 7. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen 15 (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general 16 circulation.
