MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Education, Arts and Culture and Finance to which was referred House Bill No. 7550, introduced by Rep. Umali, R., *et. al.*, entitled:

**"AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE
PHILIPPINES (PUP) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BANSUD, PROVINCE OF
ORIENTAL MINDORO, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PUP-BANSUD CAMPUS, MANDATING
THE PUP TO OFFER THEREAT GRADUATE, UNDERGRADUATE AND SHORT-TERM
TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL COURSES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. ON PAGE 2, BETWEEN LINES 15 AND 16, INSERT NEW SECTIONS TO BE READ AS FOLLOWS:

"SEC. 5. THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PUP - BANSUD CAMPUS SHALL ENSURE THAT THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ITS OPERATION AND PROGRAM OFFERINGS HAVE BEEN COMPLIED WITH AS DULY PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION (CHED).

SEC. 6. ALL ASSETS, REAL AND PERSONAL, PERSONNEL AND RECORDS OF THE PUP-BANSUD, AS WELL AS LIABILITIES OR OBLIGATIONS, ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED TO THE PUP. THE

POSITIONS, RIGHTS, AND SECURITY OF TENURE OF FACULTY MEMBERS AND PERSONNEL EMPLOYED AT THE PUP-BANSUD CAMPUS UNDER EXISTING LAWS PRIOR TO INTEGRATION INTO THE PUP SHALL BE RESPECTED.

ALL PARCELS OF LAND BELONGING TO THE GOVERNMENT OCCUPIED BY THE PUP-BANSUD CAMPUS ARE HEREBY DECLARED TO BE THE PROPERTY OF THE PUP AND SHALL BE TITLED UNDER THAT NAME: PROVIDED, THAT SHOULD THE PUP CEASE TO EXIST OR BE ABOLISHED, OR WOULD NO LONGER NEED SUCH PARCELS OF LAND AFOREMENTIONED, THE SAME SHALL REVERT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGU) CONCERNED.

SEC. 7. THE PROVISIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8292, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "HIGHER EDUCATION MODERNIZATION ACT OF 1997" SHALL FORM AN INTEGRAL PART OF THIS ACT AND TOGETHER SHALL SERVE AS THE GOVERNING CHARTER OF THE UNIVERSITY.

SEC. 8. ALL OTHER POWERS, FUNCTIONS, PRIVILEGES, RESPONSIBILITIES AND LIMITATIONS TO STATE UNIVERSITIES AND/OR ITS OFFICIALS UNDER EXISTING LAWS SHALL BE DEEMED GRANTED TO OR IMPOSED UPON THE UNIVERSITY AND/OR ITS OFFICIALS WHENEVER APPROPRIATE.

2. RENUMBER THE SUCCEEDING SECTIONS ACCORDINGLY.





AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CAMPUS OF THE
POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES
(PUP) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BANSUD,
PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO, TO BE KNOWN
AS THE PUP-BANSUD CAMPUS, MANDATING
THE PUP TO OFFER THEREAT GRADUATE,
UNDERGRADUATE AND SHORT-TERM TECHNICAL-
VOCATIONAL COURSES, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP-Bansud
2 Campus Act".

3 SEC. 2. There is hereby established a campus of the
4 Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) in the Municipality
5 of Bansud, Province of Oriental Mindoro, to be known as the
6 PUP-Bansud Campus.

7 SEC. 3. The PUP shall admit students to its Bansud Campus
8 who may avail of graduate, undergraduate and short-term
9 technical-vocational courses within the University's areas of

1 specialization and according to its capabilities as the Board of
2 Regents (BOR) may deem necessary to carry out the University's
3 objectives, particularly to respond to the needs of the province and
4 the rest of the Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon and Palawan
5 (MIMAROPA) Region.

6 The PUP is also mandated to undertake research
7 and extension services in the Bansud Campus, and to provide
8 progressive leadership in these areas, including the offering
9 of graduate degrees under the PUP Open University System.

10 SEC. 4. The PUP-Bansud Campus shall be headed by a
11 Campus Administrator who shall render full-time service and
12 who shall be appointed or designated by the BOR upon the
13 recommendation of the Search Committee and the President,
14 subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards set by
15 the BOR.

16 SEC. 5. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of
17 this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

18 SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act
19 is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts or
20 provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

21 SEC. 7. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders,
22 rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions
23 of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

24 SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
25 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper
26 of general circulation.
