

RESOLUTION

COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING SENATOR EMMANUEL "MANNY" PACQUIAO FOR WINNING THE WORLD BOXING ASSOCIATION (WBA) WORLD WELTERWEIGHT TITLE LAST JULY 15, 2018 AT THE AXIATA ARENA IN KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2018 at the Axiata Arena in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, boxer and senator Emmanuel "Manny" Pacquiao claimed the World Boxing Association (WBA) World Welterweight Title Belt, his 4th welterweight world title, and handed Argentine boxer Lucas Matthysse his first defeat since 2015 via technical knockout (TKO) in the 7th round;

WHEREAS, Pacquiao, 39 years old, now boasts 60 wins (39 by knockouts), 7 losses and 2 draws in his highly successful boxing legacy;

WHEREAS, this accomplishment is even more astonishing as the legendary boxing senator bested Matthysse, a younger, taller, and heavier opponent who was dubbed a "pressure fighter with a penchant for stopping bouts early" ¹;

WHEREAS, despite the obvious advantages of the Argentine boxer, it posed no threat to Pacquiao as he put on display his veteran experience, dropping Matthysse three times before the referee stopped the fight;

WHEREAS, this victory, a testament to the grit, perseverance, and the indomitable spirit of Pacquiao to dominate – even against younger opponents, elevates Pacquiao as the first and only 8-weight division boxing champion;
