## INTRODUCED BY SENATORS LEGARDA, ANGARA AND DRILON

AN ACT GRANTING SURVIVORSHIP BENEFITS DEPENDENT CHILDREN TO THE OF DECEASED RETIRED **MEMBER** OF COMMISSION ON AUDIT. CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS. AND THE OMBUDSMAN, WHO IS A SOLO PARENT, OR THE SURVIVING PARENTS OR NOMINATED PERSONS OF SUCH DECEASED RETIREE. AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10084, ENTITLED: "AN ACT GRANTING SURVIVORSHIP BENEFITS TO THE SURVIVING **LEGITIMATE** SPOUSE OF DECEASED RETIRED **MEMBER** OF THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT. CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS AND THE OMBUDSMAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Republic Act No 10084 is hereby amended
- 2 to include a new Section 1-A to read as follows:

1	"SEC. 1-A. IN CASE THE DECEASED
2	RETIRED CHAIRMAN OR COMMISSIONER
3	OF THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT, THE
4	COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS, THE CIVIL
5	SERVICE COMMISSION, AND THE
6	OMBUDSMAN WAS UNMARRIED, THE
7	SURVIVORSHIP BENEFITS SHALL BE PAID AS
8	FOLLOWS:
9	"(A) WHEN THE DECEASED RETIREE
10	WAS A SOLO PARENT, AS DEFINED UNDER
11	REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8972, OTHERWISE
12	KNOWN AS THE 'SOLO PARENTS' WELFARE
13	ACT OF 2000', AND SURVIVED BY
14	DEPENDENT CHILDREN OR OTHER
15	CHILDREN UNDER THE CARE OF THE
16	DECEASED RETIREE AS STIPULATED UNDER
17	REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9262, OTHERWISE
18	KNOWN AS THE 'ANTI-VIOLENCE AGAINST
19	WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN ACT OF 2004',
20	INCLUDING CHILDREN WHO HAVE

1	REACHED THE AGE OF MAJORITY BUT
2	ARE UNABLE TO FULLY TAKE CARE OF
3	THEMSELVES OR PROTECT THEMSELVES
4	FROM ABUSE, NEGLECT, CRUELTY,
5	EXPLOITATION, OR DISCRIMINATION
6	BECAUSE OF A PHYSICAL OR MENTAL
7	DISABILITY OR CONDITION AS DEFINED
8	UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7610, OTHERWISE
9	KNOWN AS THE 'SPECIAL PROTECTION OF
10	CHILDREN AGAINST ABUSE, EXPLOITATION
11	AND DISCRIMINATION ACT, THE
12	DEPENDENT CHILDREN SHALL BE
13	ENTITLED TO RECEIVE ON A MONTHLY
14	BASIS ALL THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS
15	THAT THE DECEASED RETIREE WAS
16	RECEIVING AT THE TIME OF DEATH UNDER
17	THE PROVISIONS OF APPLICABLE
18	RETIREMENT LAWS THEN IN FORCE. THE
19	MINOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN SHALL BE
20	DISQUALIFIED FROM RECEIVING THE

1	BENEFITS UPON REACHING THE AGE OF
2	MAJORITY. ANY SUBSEQUENT DEATH OR
3	DISQUALIFICATION OF ANY OF THE
4	DEPENDENT CHILDREN SHALL NOT RESULT
5	IN THE ACCRUAL OF THE FORFEITED
6	BENEFITS TO THE OTHER BENEFICIARIES.
7	"(B) WHEN THE RETIREE DIED
8	WITHOUT ISSUE, THE SURVIVING PARENTS,
9	IF ANY, OR UNLESS OTHERWISE
10	DISQUALIFIED BY LAW, ANY PERSON OR
11	PERSONS NOMINATED BY THE CHAIRMAN,
12	COMMISSIONER, OR THE OMBUDSMAN,
13	SHALL, PRIOR TO OR ON THE DATE OF
14	RETIREMENT RECEIVE ON A MONTHLY
15	BASIS ALL THE RETIREMENT BENEFITS
16	THAT THE DECEASED RETIREE WAS
17	RECEIVING AT THE TIME OF DEATH UNDER
18	THE PROVISIONS OF APPLICABLE
19	RETIREMENT LAWS THEN IN FORCE:
20	PROVIDED, THAT THE NOMINEES SHALL

1	BE LIMITED TO TWO (2) PERSONS ONLY:
2	PROVIDED, FURTHER, ANY SUBSEQUENT
3	DEATH OR DISQUALIFICATION OF ANY OF
4	THE FOREGOING BENEFICIARIES SHALL
5	NOT RESULT IN THE ACCRUAL OF THE
6	FORFEITED BENEFITS TO THE OTHER
7	BENEFICIARIES."
8	SEC. 2. Republic Act No. 10084 is hereby amended to
9	include a new Section 1-B to read as follows:
10	"SEC. 1-B. THE BENEFITS UNDER THIS
11	ACT SHALL BE GRANTED TO A CHAIRMAN
12	OR COMMISSIONER OF THE COMMISSION ON
13	AUDIT, THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION,
14	THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS, AND THE
15	OMBUDSMAN WHO HAVE RETIRED PRIOR TO
16	THE EFFECTIVITY OF THIS ACT: PROVIDED,
17	THAT THE BENEFITS TO BE GRANTED
18	SHALL BE PROSPECTIVE."
19	SEC. 3. Funds for the initial implementation of this
20	Act shall be taken out of the current appropriations for

- 1 the retirement benefits of the Chairman and
- 2 Commissioners of the Constitutional Commissions as well
- 3 as the Ombudsman, or savings of said Constitutional
- 4 Commissions and the Office of the Ombudsman.
- 5 Thereafter, the amounts needed for the continued
- 6 implementation hereof shall be included in the annual
- 7 General Appropriations Act.
- 8 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
- 9 after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any
- 10 newspaper of general circulation.
