

#### MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committee on Labor, Employment and Human Resources Development to which was referred **Senate Bill No. 1614**, introduced by Senator Joel Villanueva, entitled:

#### "AN ACT

# INCREASING THE SERVICE INCENTIVE LEAVE PAY OF EMPLOYEES, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE ARTICLE 95 OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES"

has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

- On page 1, line 9, after the word "pay" insert the punctuation comma "," and the phrase "PROVIDED THAT, THE EMPLOYEE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO CONVERT ONLY FIVE DAYS OF LEAVE TO ITS MONEY EQUIVALENT IF NOT USED OR EXHAUSTED AT THE END OF THE YEAR".
- On the same page, line 15, after the word "Labor" insert the phrase "and Employment".
- Finally, the secretariat is directed to reformat the bill subject to its rules and style.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article 95 of the Labor Code currently grants every employee who has rendered at least one year of service to a yearly service incentive leave of only five days with pay.

Recent studies have shown, however, that taking leaves increases the productivity of workers, improves employee morale, fosters stronger employee retention and gives significant health benefits. Meanwhile, some research also suggests that the cost of paid leaves to employers is very little, "in terms of temporary employee replacement costs or overtime paid to existing employees and has few if any costs-and potentially gains-in terms of employee morale and productivity."1 In fact, in the Philippines, private companies often give vacation and sick leaves to their employees, above the mandatory five-day service incentive leave under the Labor Code, as an additional benefit.

Given the benefits of giving paid leaves to employees, this bill seeks to increase the mandatory 5-day service incentive leave under the Labor Code to 10 days

The immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

1 2	Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
3	SECTION 1 Article OF A DE LA D
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> Article 95 of Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7	"Article 95. Right to service incentive leave – (a) Every employee who
8	has refluered at least one year of service shall be entitled to a yearly
10	service incentive leave of [five] TEN days with pay.
11	(b) This provision shall not apply to those who are already enjoying the
12	benefit herein provided, those enjoying vacation leave with pay of at
13	least [five] TEN days and those employed in establishments regularly
14	employing less than ten employees or in establishments exampted
15	from granting this benefit by the Secretary of Labor after considering
16	the viability or financial condition of such establishment.
17	
18	(c) The grant of benefit in excess of that provided herein shall not be
19	made a subject of arbitration or any court or administrative action."

21	SEC. 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations Within ninety (90) days from the
22	approval of this Act, the Department of Labor and Employment in consultation
23	relevant stakeholders, shall promulgate the implementing rules and regulations of
24	this Act.

SEC. 3. Repealing Clause. – All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SEC. 4. Effectivity. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
