

AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO BRUCE DONALD MCTAVISH

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Bruce Donald McTavish is hereby granted Philippine citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives appurtenant thereto. Upon taking and registration of the oath of allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines, Bruce McTavish shall enter the full enjoyment of the Philippine citizenship.

Sec. 2. Repealing Clause. – All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Sec. 3. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication either in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines.

AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO BRUCE DONALD MCTAVISH

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Mr. Bruce Donald McTavish is hereby granted
 Philippine citizenship with all the rights, privileges and
 prerogatives, and is likewise vested with the duties and obligations
 appurtenant thereto.
- SEC. 2. Mr. Bruce Donald McTavish shall take the Oath of Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines before an officer duly authorized to administer the same. The Oath of Allegiance shall be registered with the Bureau of Immigration.
- SEC. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of Immigration shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization to Mr. McTavish who shall thereupon enter into the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

- 1 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
- 2 its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper
- 3 of general circulation.
