

# AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO FATHER JULIAN C. MAZANA

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Fr. Julian C. Mazana is hereby granted Philippine citizenship will all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as the duties and obligations appurtenant thereto.

SEC. 2. Fr. Julian C. Mazana shall take the Oath of Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines before an officer duly authorized to administer the same. The Oath of Allegiance shall be registered with the Bureau of Immigration.

SEC. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of Immigration shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization to Fr. Julian C. Mazana who shall thereupon enter into the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.
