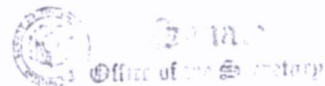



### AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO FATHER JULIAN C. MAZANA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. Fr. Julian C. Mazana is hereby granted Philippine  
2 citizenship will all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as  
3 the duties and obligations appurtenant thereto.

4           SEC. 2. Fr. Julian C. Mazana shall take the Oath of  
5 Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines before an officer duly  
6 authorized to administer the same. The Oath of Allegiance shall be  
7 registered with the Bureau of Immigration.

8           SEC. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the  
9 Bureau of Immigration shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization to  
10 Fr. Julian C. Mazana who shall thereupon enter into the full  
11 enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

1           SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
2 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general  
3 circulation.
