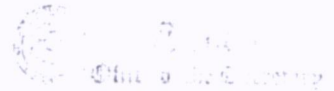

be approved in substitution of Senate Bill Nos. 100 and 1893 with Senators Gordon, De Lima, and Pimentel III as authors thereof.







AN ACT
AMENDING SECTION 15 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8436, AS
AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9369

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** Section 15 of Republic Act No. 8436, as amended by R.A. No.
2 9369, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 **SECTION 15.** *Official Ballot.* – xxxx.

4 xxxx.

5 For this purpose, the Commission shall set the deadline for the
6 filing of certificate of candidacy/petition for registration/manifestation
7 to participate in the election. A person [who] **SHALL BE**
8 **CONSIDERED A CANDIDATE AT THE MOMENT SUCH PERSON**
9 files [his] **A** certificate of candidacy within [this period shall only be
10 considered as a candidate at the start of the campaign period for which
11 he filed his certificate of candidacy] **THE PERIOD PROVIDED BY**
12 **THE COMMISSION**; *Provided, That, unlawful acts or omissions*

1 applicable to a candidate shall take effect [only] upon [the start of the
2 aforesaid campaign period] **THE FILING OF THE CERTIFICATE OF**
3 **CANDIDACY**; *Provided, finally,* That any person holding a public
4 appointive office or position, including active members of the armed
5 forces, and officers and employees in government-owned or -controlled
6 corporations, shall be considered *ipso facto* resigned from [his/her]
7 office and must vacate the same at the start of the day [of the filing of
8 his/her] **SUCH PERSON FILED A** certificate of candidacy.

13 **SECTION 2. *Repealing Clause.*** - All laws, decrees, orders, and issuances, or
14 portions thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act, are hereby
15 repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

16 **SECTION 3. *Effectivity.*** - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
17 publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
