

AN ACT CONVERTING THE QUEZON LICENSING CENTER
OF THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE (LTO)
IN LUCENA CITY, PROVINCE OF QUEZON INTO A
REGULAR LICENSING CENTER TO BE KNOWN AS
THE "LUCENA CITY LICENSING CENTER" AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The Land Transportation Office (LTO) Quezon
2 Licensing Center in the City of Lucena, Province of Quezon is
3 hereby converted into a regular LTO licensing center.
4 SEC. 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall immediately
5 include in the Department's program the operationalization of the

1 Lucena City Licensing Center, the initial funding of which shall be
2 charged against the current year's appropriation of the Quezon
3 Licensing Center. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for the
4 continued implementation of this Act shall be included in the
5 annual General Appropriations Act.

6 SEC. 3. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act,
7 the Secretary of Transportation shall issue such rules and
8 regulations necessary for its effective implementation.

9 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following
10 the completion of its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a
11 newspaper of general circulation.
