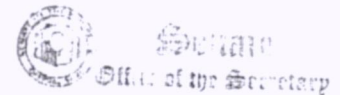

Recommending its approval with amendments.

Sponsor: Senator Angara

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which were referred **House Bill No. 5223**, introduced by Representative Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang, entitled:

"AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, delete lines 5-9 and in lieu thereof, insert a new Section to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES. – THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF BARANGAY BULANAO NORTE SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

Line	Direction	Adjoining Lots/Features
1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12-13-14	NW	Barangay San Juan, Tabuk City
14-15-16-17-18	N, NE, & SE	Proposed Barangay Ipil, Tabuk City

2. On the same page, line 11, after the acronym "(COMELEC)", insert the phrase **"ON DECEMBER 21, 2002 IN BARANGAY BULANAO"**.

3. Still on the same page, line 13, after the name "Kalinga", delete the phrase "in Barangay Bulanao".
4. Still on page 1, lines 14-15, delete the phrase "as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 21, 2002".

BY REPRESENTATIVE MANGAOANG, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 162

AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF
KALINGA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte.* – The Sitio of
2 Bulanao Norte is hereby separated from Barangay Bulanao and constituted
3 into a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Bulanao
4 Norte in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga.

5 The territorial boundaries of Barangay Bulanao Norte are hereby
6 described as follows:

7 “Bounded on the East by Barangay Ipil; on the South and Southwest by
8 Barangay Bulanao Centro; and on the Northwest by Barangay San Juan and
9 Barangay Appas.”

10 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
11 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
12 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-002 of the Sangguniang
13 Panlalawigan of the Province of Kalinga in Barangay Bulanao, which ratified
14 the creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board
15 of Canvassers on December 21, 2002, shall serve as substantial compliance

1 with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
2 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

3 SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
4 officials of Barangay Bulanao Norte shall continue to hold office until such
5 time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

6 SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public infrastructure
7 and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this
8 Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be
9 administered by the new barangay.

10 SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay Bulanao Norte
11 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
12 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
13 "Local Government Code of 1991".

14 SEC. 6. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
15 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
