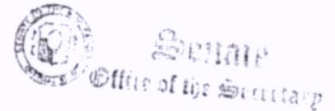

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which were referred **House Bill No. 5222**, introduced by Representative Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang, entitled:

"AN ACT SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF GUINA-ANG, MADOPDOP, MALLANGO, LANLANA AND SAN PABLO FROM BARANGAY LACNOG, CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY LACNOG WEST"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, delete lines 5-9 and in lieu thereof, insert a new Section to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES. – THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF BARANGAY LACNOG WEST SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

BY REPRESENTATIVE MANGAOANG, PER COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 161

AN ACT SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF GUINA-ANG, MADOPDOP, MALLANGO, LANLANA AND SAN PABLO FROM BARANGAY LACNOG, CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY LACNOG WEST

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Lacnog West.* – The sitios of
2 Guina-ang, Madopdop, Mallango, Lanlana and San Pablo are hereby separated
3 from Barangay Lacnog in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute
4 a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Lacnog West.

5 The territorial boundaries of Barangay Lacnog West are hereby
6 described as follows:

7 “Bounded on the Southeast by Barangay Agbannawag; on the
8 Southwest by Barangay Bulo; on the Northwest by Barangay Ipil; on the North
9 by Barangay Nambaran; and on the East by Barangay Lacnog East.”

10 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – Pursuant to
11 Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
12 “Local Government Code of 1991”, the new Barangay Lacnog West shall exist

1 upon the approval by a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters of
2 Barangay Lacnog in a plebiscite to be conducted and supervised by the
3 Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in the area affected, within ninety (90)
4 days from the effectivity of this Act.

5 The amount necessary for the conduct of such plebiscite shall be borne
6 by the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga.

7 SEC. 3. *Barangay Officials.* – The first set of officials of Barangay
8 Lacnog West shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor and shall hold
9 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
10 qualified.

11 SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
12 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
13 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
14 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

15 SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay Lacnog West
16 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
17 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
18 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

19 SEC. 6. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
20 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
