

AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO
MARGARITA MELIAN ORTIGAS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Ms. Margarita Melian Ortigas is hereby granted
2 Philippine citizenship with all the rights, privileges and
3 prerogatives, as well as the duties and obligations appurtenant
4 thereto under the Constitution and the laws of the Republic of the
5 Philippines.

6 SEC. 2. Ms. Margarita Melian Ortigas shall take the Oath of
7 Allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines before an officer duly
8 authorized to administer the same. The Oath of Allegiance shall be
9 registered with the Bureau of Immigration.

10 SEC. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the
11 Bureau of Immigration shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization
12 to Ms. Margarita Melian Ortigas who shall thereupon enter into
13 the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

1 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
2 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
3 circulation.
