has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that the attached H.B. No. 8155 be approved with the following amendments:

- 1. On page 6, line 3, delete the phrase "whether as a whole or in part,";
- 2. On the same page, line 4, delete the words "and whether";
- 3. On the same page, lines 6 and 7, after the word "Philippines" insert a period (.) and delete the phrase "and compliance with legal requirements stipulated in other statutes:" and in lieu thereof insert a new phrase "CONGRESS SHALL BE INFORMED OF ANY SALE, LEASE, TRANSFER, GRANT OF USUFRUCT, OR ASSIGNMENT OF FRANCHISE OR THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES ACQUIRED THEREUNDER, OR OF THE MERGER OR TRANSFER OF THE CONTROLLING INTEREST OF THE GRANTEE, WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE SAID TRANSACTION. FAILURE TO REPORT TO CONGRESS SUCH CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP SHALL RENDER THE FRANCHISE IPSO FACTO REVOKED."; also on line 7 after the word "statutes" and colon (:) delete the words "Provided, That" and capitalize letter "a" in the word "any";
- 4. On the same page, line 26, before the word "Any", insert the phrase "**EXCEPT FOR TAXES AND CUSTOMS DUTIES**,".

AN ACT RENEWING FOR ANOTHER TWENTY-FIVE (25) YEARS THE FRANCHISE GRANTED TO CATHOLIC BISHOPS' CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINES, INC., UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 5172, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7530 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

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SECTION 1. Nature and Scope of Franchise. - Subject to the provisions of the Constitution and applicable laws, rules and regulations, the franchise granted to Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines, Inc., hereunder referred to as the grantee, its successors or assignees, under Republic Act No. 5172, as amended by Republic Act No. 7530, to construct, install, establish, operate. and maintain for religious, educational, cultural, and commercial purposes and in the public interest, radio and/or television broadcasting stations in the Philippines, where frequencies and/or channels are still available or are assigned for radio and/or television broadcasting, including digital television and/or radio systems, through microwave, satellite, or the use of any new technology in television and/or radio systems, with the corresponding technological auxiliaries and/or facilities, special broadcast, and other program and distribution services and relay stations, is hereby renewed for another twenty-five (25) years from the effectivity of this Act.

SEC. 2. Manner of Operation of Stations or Facilities. - The stations or facilities of the grantee shall be constructed and operated in a manner as will, at most, result only in the minimum interference on the wavelengths or frequencies of existing stations or other stations which may be established by law, without in any way diminishing its own privilege to use its assigned wavelengths or frequencies and the quality of transmission or reception thereon as should maximize rendition of the grantee's services and/or the availability thereof.

international humanitarian organizations duly recognized by statutes: *Provided*, That the NTC shall increase the public service time in case of extreme emergency or calamity. The NTC shall issue rules and regulations for this purpose, the effectivity of which shall commence upon applicability with other similarly situated broadcast network franchise holders.

SEC. 5. Right of the Government. — The radio spectrum is a finite resource that is part of the national patrimony and the use thereof is a privilege conferred upon the grantee by the State and may be withdrawn any time after due process.

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A special right is hereby reserved to the President of the Philippines, in times of war, rebellion, public peril, calamity, emergency, disaster, or disturbance of peace and order; to temporarily take over and operate the stations or facilities of the grantee; to temporarily suspend the operation of any station or facility in the interest of public safety, security and public welfare; or to authorize the temporary use and operation thereof by any agency of the government, upon due compensation to the grantee, for the use of said stations or facilities during the period when these shall be so operated.

SEC. 6. Term of Franchise. — This franchise shall be for a term of twenty-five (25) years from the date of the effectivity of this Act, unless sooner revoked or cancelled. In the event the grantee fails to operate continuously for two (2) years, this franchise shall be deemed ipso facto revoked.

SEC. 7. Self-regulation by and Undertaking of the Grantee. The grantee shall not require any previous censorship of any
speech, play, act, or scene, or other matter to be broadcast from

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its stations: *Provided*, That the grantee, during any broadcast, shall cut off from the air the speech, play, act, or scene, or other matter being broadcast if the tendency thereof is to propose and/or incite treason, rebellion or sedition; or the language used therein or the theme thereof is indecent or immoral: *Provided*, *further*, That willful failure to do so shall constitute a valid cause for the cancellation of this franchise.

SEC. 8. Warranty in Favor of the National and Local Governments. - The grantee shall hold the national provincial, city, and municipal governments of the Philippines free from all claims, liabilities, demands, or actions arising out of accidents causing injury to persons or damage to properties, during the construction or operation of the stations of the grantee.

SEC. 9. Commitment to Provide and Promote the Creation of Employment Opportunities. — The grantee shall create employment opportunities and shall allow on-the-job trainings in their franchise operation: Provided, That priority shall be accorded to the residents in areas where any of its offices is located: Provided, further, That the grantee shall follow the applicable labor standards and allowance entitlement under existing labor laws, rules and regulations and similar issuances: Provided, finally, That the employment opportunities or jobs created shall be reflected in the General Information Sheet to be submitted to the Securities and Exchange Commission annually.

SEC. 10. Sale, Lease, Transfer, Grant of Usufruct, or Assignment of Franchise. - The grantee shall not sell, lease, transfer, grant the usufruct of, nor assign this franchise or the rights and privileges acquired thereunder to any person, firm, 1.1

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company, corporation, or other commercial or legal entity, nor merge with any other corporation or entity, nor shall transfer the controlling interest of the grantee, whether as a whole or in part, and whether simultaneously or contemporaneously, to any such person, firm, company, corporation, or entity without the prior approval of the Congress of the Philippines and compliance with legal requirements stipulated in other statutes. Provided, That any person or entity to which this franchise is validly sold, transferred, or assigned shall be subject to the same conditions, terms, restrictions, and limitations of this Act.

SEC. 11. Reportorial Requirement. — The grantee shall submit an annual report to the Congress of the Philippines, through the Committee on Legislative Franchises of the House of Representatives and the Committee on Public Services of the Philippine Senate, on its compliance with the terms and conditions of the franchise and on its operations on or before April 30 of every year during the term of its franchise. The reportorial compliance certificate issued by Congress shall be required before any application for permit or certificate is accepted by the NTC.

SEC. 12. Fine. - Failure of the grantee to submit the requisite annual report to Congress shall be penalized by a fine of Five hundred pesos (P500.00) per working day of noncompliance. The fine shall be collected by the NTC from the delinquent franchise grantee separate from the reportorial penalties imposed by the NTC and the same shall be remitted to the National Treasury.

SEC. 13. Equality Clause. - Any advantage, favor, privilege, exemption, or immunity granted under existing franchises, or which may hereafter be granted for radio and/or television broadcasting.

upon prior review and approval of Congress, shall become part
to of this franchise and shall be accorded immediately and
unconditionally to the herein grantee: *Provided*, That the foregoing
shall neither apply to nor affect provisions of broadcasting
franchises concerning territorial coverage, the term, or the type of
service authorized by the franchise.

SEC. 14. Repealability and Nonexclusivity Clause. This franchise shall be subject to amendment, alteration, or repeal by the Congress of the Philippines when the public interest so requires and shall not be interpreted as an exclusive grant of the privileges herein provided for.

SEC. 15. Separability Clause. - If any of the sections or provisions of this Act is held invalid, all other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid.

SEC. 16. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, resolutions, instructions, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SEC. 17. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
