



*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. November 28 of every year is hereby declared a
2 special nonworking holiday in the Province of Sarangani in
3 commemoration of its founding anniversary.

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
6 circulation.
