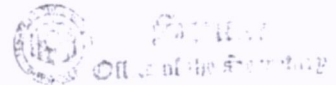

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled.*

1 SECTION 1. February 13 of every year is hereby declared a
2 special nonworking holiday in the City of Parañaque, Metro Manila,
3 in commemoration of its founding anniversary.

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
6 circulation.
