The Committees on Health and Demography, and Finance, to which were referred House Bill No. 7355, introduced by Representatives Edcel C. Lagman and Karlo Alexei B. Nograles, entitled:

AN ACT

CONVERTING THE ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF TABACO, PROVINCE OF ALBAY, INTO AN EXTENSION HOSPITAL OF THE BICOL REGIONAL TRAINING AND TEACHING HOSPITAL, AND INCREASING ITS BED CAPACITY FROM FIFTY (50) TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) BEDS TO BE NOW KNOWN AS THE DR. LORENZO P. ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

AS THE DR. LORENZO P. ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

have considered the same and have the honor to report back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 7355, taking into consideration Senate Bill No. 1967 be approved with the following amendments:

1. On Page 1, delete lines 1 to 8, and replace it with the following:

SECTION 1. THE ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF TABACO, PROVINCE OF ALBAY IS HEREBY RENAMED AS THE DR. LORENZO P. ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL, AND ITS AUTHORIZED BED CAPACITY IS HEREBY INCREASED FROM (50) TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) BEDS.

2. On Page 2, delete lines 6-13 (Sections 3 and 4). Replace with the following new Sections:

SECTION 3. IF ANY PROVISION OR PART OF THIS ACT IS DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL THE REMAINING PARTS OR PROVISIONS NOT AFFECTED SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

SECTION 4. ALL OTHER LAWS, DECREES, ORDERS, ISSUANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT ARE HEREBY REPEALED, AMENDED OR MODIFIED ACCORDINGLY.

3. Delete the title of the bill and replace with the following:

AN ACT

INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF TABACO, PROVINCE OF ALBAY FROM FIFTY (50) TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) BEDS, TO BE NOW KNOWN AS THE DR. LORENZO P. ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

AN ACT CONVERTING THE ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF TABACO, PROVINCE OF ALBAY, INTO AN EXTENSION HOSPITAL OF THE BICOL REGIONAL TRAINING AND TEACHING HOSPITAL, AND INCREASING ITS BED CAPACITY FROM FIFTY (50) TO TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (250) BEDS TO BE NOW KNOWN AS THE DR. LORENZO P. ZIGA MEMORIAL DISTRICT HOSPITAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. The Ziga Memorial District Hospital in the City
- of Tabaco, Province of Albay, is hereby converted into an extension
- 3 hospital of the Bicol Regional Training and Teaching Hospital
- 4 (BRTTH) to be now known as the Dr. Lorenzo P. Ziga Memorial
- 5 District Hospital.
- 6 The authorized bed capacity of the Dr. Lorenzo P. Ziga
- 7 Memorial District Hospital is hereby increased from fifty (50) to two
- 8 hundred fifty (250) beds.

	SEC. 2.	The	existing	hospit	al f	acilities	and	profession	nal
health care services of the Dr. Lorenzo P. Ziga Memorial District									
Hospital are hereby upgraded and increased to conform with and be									
con	nmensurat	e to	the incre	ase in	bed	capacity.	The	number	of
medical personnel shall be correspondingly increased.									

- SEC. 3. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- SEC. 4. The Department of Health shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the operation of the subject extension hospital within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act.
- SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general circulation.
