

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE SAN LORENZO RUIZ WOMEN'S HOSPITAL IN
MALABON CITY, METRO MANILA INTO A GENERAL HOSPITAL TO BE
KNOWN AS THE SAN LORENZO RUIZ GENERAL HOSPITAL,
INCREASING ITS BED CAPACITY FROM TEN (10) TO TWO HUNDRED
(200) BEDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines
in Congress assembled:*

- 1 **SECTION 1.** The San Lorenzo Ruiz Women's Hospital in Malabon City, Metro
2 Manila is hereby converted into a general hospital to be known as the San
3 Lorenzo Ruiz General Hospital.
- 4 **SECTION 2.** The authorized bed capacity of the San Lorenzo Ruiz General
5 Hospital in Malabon City, Metro Manila is hereby increased from ten (10) to two
6 hundred (200) beds.
- 7 **SECTION 3.** The existing professional health care services, facilities and health
8 human resource of the San Lorenzo Ruiz General Hospital are hereby upgraded
9 to conform and be commensurate to the increase in its authorized bed capacity
10 as provided for in Section 2 hereof. The increase in bed capacity from ten (10) to

1 two hundred (200) beds shall be implemented consistent with the five (5)-year
2 development plan of the hospital.

3 **SECTION 4.** The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the
4 Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which
5 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

6 **SECTION 5.** Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary
7 of Health shall, in consultation with the Secretary of Budget and Management,
8 promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation
9 of this Act.

10 **SECTION 6.** If any provision or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the
11 remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

12 **SECTION 7.** All other laws, decrees, orders, issuances, rules and regulations, or
13 parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby
14 repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

15 **SECTION 8.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
16 the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
