#### Mr. President:

The Committees on Health and Demography, and Finance, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 1968, introduced by Senator Joseph Victor G. Ejercito, entitled:

#### AN ACT

INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE AMANG RODRIGUEZ MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA FROM THREE HUNDRED (300) TO FIVE HUNDRED (500) BEDS, UPGRADING THE SERVICE FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE THEREIN, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

and taking into consideration House Bill No. 7065, introduced by Representatives Bayani F. Fernando, Chiqui Roa-Puno and Karlo Alexei Nograles, entitled:

#### AN ACT

INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE AMANG RODRIGUEZ MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA FROM THREE HUNDRED (300) TO FIVE HUNDRED (500) BEDS, UPGRADING THE SERVICE FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL

# HEALTH CARE THEREIN, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

have considered the same and have the honor to report back to the Senate with the recommendation that Senate Bill No. 1968, taking into consideration House Bill No. 7065 be approved with the following amendments:

- 1. On Page 2, line 1, add "s" to the word "Section" and insert the number "1" and the word "AND" between the words "Section" and "2."
- On the same page lines 1-2, delete the phrase "within a period of not more than three (3) years from the approval of this Act." Replace it with the following phrase: "CONSISTENT WITH THE FIVE-YEAR DEVELEOPMENT PLAN OF THE HOSPITAL."

Thus, SEC. 4 as amended shall now read as follows:

- **SEC. 4.** The increase in the bed capacity of the ARMMC from three hundred (300) to five hundred (500) and the upgrading of its facilities as provided for under Sections **1** AND 2 of this Act shall be implemented **CONSISTENT WITH THE FIVE-YEAR DEVELEOPMENT PLAN OF THE HOSPITAL.**
- On page 2, after line 6, insert a new Section, which shall read as follows:
   SEC. 6. IF ANY PROVISION OR PART OF THIS ACT IS
   DECLARED UNCONSTITUTIONAL THE REMAINING PARTS OR
   PROVISIONS NOT AFFECTED SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE
   AND EFFECT.
- 4. Renumber the succeeding Sections accordingly.
- 4. On page 2, line 9, add as second sentence the following: "ALL OTHER LAWS, DECREES, ORDERS, ISSUANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS, OR PARTS THEREOF WHICH ARE INCONSISTENT WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT ARE HEREBY REPEALED, AMENDED OR MODIFIED ACCORDINGLY."



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# INTRODUCED BY SENATOR JOSEPH VICTOR G. EJERCITO

#### AN ACT

INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE AMANG RODRIGUEZ MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA FROM THREE HUNDRED (300) TO FIVE HUNDRED (500) BEDS, UPGRADING THE SERVICE FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE THEREIN, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Section 11, Article XIII of the 1987 Constitution of the Philippines, provides that:

"The State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers."

The 'Amang' Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center is a tertiary licensed facility, a teaching and training center under the Department of Health. It has been considered "a referral center" for more complicated cases in the eastern part of Rizal and the other provinces. Recently, its authorized bed capacity was increase from One Hundred Fifty (150) beds

to Three Hundred (300) beds as per R.A. No. 9419, dated February 19,  $2007.^1$ 

There is an urgent need to upgrade the health facilities of the hospital to cater efficiently to the needs of the people.

This is the most opportune time to increase the 'Amang' Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center's bed capacity from 300 to 500 beds in order to conform with the policy of the State to provide quality and efficient health care service, in relation to the national government's health care agenda.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate passage of this measure is earnestly sought.

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# INTRODUCED BY SENATOR JOSEPH VICTOR G. EJERCITO

#### AN ACT

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The authorized bed capacity of the Amang Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center (ARMMC) in the City of Marikina is hereby increased from three hundred (300) to five hundred (500).

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**SECTION 2.** The existing hospital facilities and profession health care services of the ARMMC are also hereby upgraded and increased to conform with and be commensurate to the increase in bed capacity.

**SECTION 3.** Upon prior consultation with the Amang Rodriguez Memorial Medical Center, the Department of Health shall, in coordination with the Department Budget and Management and the Civil Service Commission, determine the additional plantilla positions to be created and filled up in the workforce of the ARMMC.

**SECTION 4.** The increase in the bed capacity of the ARMMC from three hundred (300) to five hundred (500) and the upgrading of its facilities as

2	period of not more than three (3) years from the approval of this Act.
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4	SECTION 5. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the
5	Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of
6	which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
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8	SECTION 6. Republic Act No. 7209, as amended by Republic Act No.
9	9419, is hereby further amended.
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11	SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
12	publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
