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AN ACT SEPARATING THE HIGH SCHOOL DEPARTMENT OF STA. ROSA INTEGRATED SCHOOL IN BARANGAY STA. ROSA, MUNICIPALITY OF CONCEPCION, PROVINCE OF TARLAC, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS STA. ROSA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND RENAMING THE SURVIVING SCHOOL AS STA. ROSA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. The high school department of Sta. Rosa  
2 Integrated School in Barangay Sta. Rosa, Municipality of  
3 Concepcion, Province of Tarlac is hereby separated from  
4 Sta. Rosa Integrated School and converted into an independent  
5 national high school to be known as Sta. Rosa National High School.  
6 THE SURVIVING SCHOOL, NAMELY, STA. ROSA INTEGRATED  
7 SCHOOL, GIVEN THAT IT WILL NO LONGER HAVE A HIGH  
8 SCHOOL DEPARTMENT SHALL HERINAFTER BE RENAMED  
9 AS STA. ROSA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

1           SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the  
2 high school department of Sta. Rosa Integrated School are hereby  
3 transferred to and absorbed by Sta. Rosa National High School.

4           SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include  
5 in the Department's program the operationalization of Sta. Rosa  
6 National High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged  
7 against the current year's appropriation of the high school  
8 department of Sta. Rosa Integrated School. Thereafter, the amount  
9 necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included  
10 in the annual General Appropriations Act.

11          SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules  
12 and regulations necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act  
13 within one hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

14          SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
15 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general  
16 circulation.
