





AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
CENTRAL BICUTAN IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO
MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Central Bicutan.* – The Central
2 Bicutan Proper in Barangay Upper Bicutan, City of Taguig, Metro Manila is
3 hereby separated from Barangay Upper Bicutan and constituted into a distinct
4 and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Central Bicutan.

5 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of
6 Barangay Central Bicutan shall consist of permanent natural boundaries
7 identified as follows:

8 “Bounded on the Northeast and East by a creek and Maharlika Road,
9 Lapu-Lapu Street and Bonifacio Street;

10 On the South by Bonifacio Street; and

11 On the West and Northwest by F.T.I. Compound and Parañaque
12 Cadastre.”

13 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
14 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
15 Barangay Upper Bicutan pursuant to City Ordinance No. 57, Series of 2008 of

1 the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation
2 of Barangay Central Bicutan as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers
3 on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with the
4 plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
5 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

6 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
7 officials of Barangay Central Bicutan, City of Taguig shall continue to hold
8 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
9 qualified.

10 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
11 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
12 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
13 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

14 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay Central
15 Bicutan herein shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares
16 pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
17 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

18 SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or
19 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or
20 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full
21 force and effect.

22 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
23 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
24 circulation.
