AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY SOUTH DAANG HARI IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO MANILA

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay South Daang Hari, - South Daang
2	Hari Proper in Barangay Bagong Tanyag, City of Taguig, Metro Manila is
3	hereby separated from Barangay Bagong Tanyag and constituted into a distinct
4	and independent barangay to be known as Barangay South Daang Hari.
5	SEC. 2. Territorial Boundaries The territorial boundaries of
6	Barangay South Daang Hari shall consist of permanent natural boundaries
7	identified as follows:
8	"Bounded on the North by the property line of Perpetual Village
9	Phase-II;
0	On the East by Manila Railroad Company (Railroad Tract); and
1	On the South by Lot-4547 Psu-13088 (Parañaque Cadastre), Lot-8042
12	Case 16 Taguig Cadastral Mapping and the Bagumbayan River."
13	SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite The plebiscite
14	conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
15	Barangay Bagong Tanyag pursuant to City Ordinance No. 26, Series of 2008

- I of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the
- 2 creation of Barangay South Daang Hari as proclaimed by the City Board of
- 3 Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with
- 4 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
- 5 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
- 6 SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials. The incumbent barangay
- 7 officials of Barangay South Daang Hari, City of Taguig shall continue to hold
- 8 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
- 9 qualified.
- 10 SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities. All public
- infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
- 12 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
- 13 and shall be administered by the new barangay.
- 14 SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares. Barangay South Daang
- 15 Hari shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
- Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
- 17 "Local Government Code of 1991".
- 18 SEC. 7. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any part or
- 19 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or
- 20 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full
- 21 force and effect.
- 22 SEC. 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
- 23 its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general
- 24 circulation.
