






AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
NORTH SIGNAL VILLAGE IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO
MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay North Signal Village.* – North
2 Signal Village Proper in Barangay Signal Village, City of Taguig, Metro
3 Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Signal Village and constituted into
4 a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay North Signal
5 Village.

6 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of
7 Barangay North Signal Village shall consist of permanent natural boundaries
8 identified as follows:

9 “Bounded on the North by the property of the Bases Conversion and
10 Development Authority (BCDA-Palakol Area and Pinagsama Village
11 Phase II);

12 On the South by M.R.T. Avenue (formerly Cuasay Street);

13 On the East by the property of BCDA (Palakol Area-Pag-asa) and
14 Dream Land Village; and

15 On the West by E.P. Housing Village Phase 2, Sampaloc Street and a
16 creek.”

17 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
18 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in

1 Barangay Signal Village pursuant to City Ordinance No. 58, Series of 2008 of
2 the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation
3 of Barangay North Signal Village as proclaimed by the City Board of
4 Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with
5 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
6 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

7 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
8 officials of Barangay North Signal Village, City of Taguig shall continue to
9 hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
10 qualified.

11 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
12 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
13 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
14 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

15 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay North Signal
16 Village herein shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares
17 pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
18 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

19 SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or
20 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or
21 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full
22 force and effect.

23 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
24 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
25 circulation.
