AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY  
SAN MIGUEL IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay San Miguel.* – San Miguel Proper  
2 in Barangay Hagonoy, City of Taguig, Metro Manila is hereby separated from  
3 Barangay Hagonoy and constituted into a distinct and independent barangay to  
4 be known as Barangay San Miguel.

5           SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of  
6 Barangay San Miguel shall consist of permanent natural boundaries identified  
7 as follows:

8           “Bounded on the North by Lot-5183, Psu-220212, Lot-5183  
9 Psu-237646 Case 11 Mcadm 590-D Barangay of Bambang, Lot-5182, 5157  
10 Case 11 590-D Mcadm 590-D Taguig Cadastral Mapping, Lot-578 Case-2  
11 Mcadm 590-D (Barangay Wawa), Rita Franco Street, and Lot-386 Psu-241598  
12 Case 2 Mcadm 590-D, M.L.Q.;

13           On the East and Southeast by Quezon Street, Lots-573, 572, 571, 570,  
14 569, 568, all in Case 2 Mcadm 590-D (Barangay Wawa), and an existing road  
15 dike;

1           On the South and Southeast by Lots-3949, 4174, 4175, 4177, 4228,  
2 4229, 4379, 4337, 4336, 4339, 4229, 4342, 4344, 4345, 4347, Mcadm 590-D  
3 Case 12 Taguig Cadastral Mapping, and a portion of Lot-8640; and

4           On the West, by Barangay Signal Village and NAPOCOR High  
5 Tension Line.”

6           SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite  
7 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in  
8 Barangay Hagonoy pursuant to City Ordinance No. 24, Series of 2008 of the  
9 Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation of  
10 Barangay San Miguel as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers on  
11 December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite  
12 requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended,  
13 otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

14           SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay  
15 officials of Barangay San Miguel, City of Taguig shall continue to hold office  
16 until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

17           SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public infrastructure  
18 and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this  
19 Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be  
20 administered by the new barangay.

21           SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay San Miguel  
22 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to  
23 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the  
24 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

25           SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or  
26 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or  
27 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full  
28 force and effect.

1           SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
2 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general  
3 circulation.
