WHEREAS, the Philippines is the host of the 30th Southeast Asian Games or the 2019 SEA Games on November 30, 2019 to December 11, 2019;

WHEREAS, in line with the duties as the host country, the Philippines has constructed various sports facilities in the New Clark City and other parts of the country;

WHEREAS, last June 18, 2019 the President of the Philippine Olympic Committee, Ricky Vargas, and other officials tendered their resignation;

WHEREAS, there have been reports of internal squabbles regarding the leadership of the Philippine Olympic Committee;

WHEREAS, there have been reports that the Philippines might not be able to comply with all its obligations as a host in time including the construction of the necessary facilities;

WHEREAS, with only four months left before the SEA Games, these disruptions will most likely affect the country's preparation as the host;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Government has invested a lot of resources and time for training and preparing their athletes;

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure that the SEA Games will proceed smoothly,
and the athletes are provided with a safe environment to compete in.

Committee on Sports to inquire on the status of the preparations by the Philippine
Sports Commission, the Philippine Olympic Committee, and the Philippine SEA Games
