EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article XV, Section 4 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides:

"The family has the duty to care for its elderly members but the State may also do so through just programs of social security."

Majority of Filipino families are bonded by common values and traits that are first taught at home and being applied in our day to day lives. Such values include having close-knit family ties. Often times, senior members of the family continue to provide for their family, giving them a strong sense of purpose and fulfillment. In addition, it gives them a feeling of pride that they do not burden their loved ones since they are able to take care of themselves.

The proposed bill seeks to augment the provision of social pension for all senior citizens in order to aid them in addressing their daily needs and ensuring that they are cared for.

In view of the foregoing, the passage of this measure is earnestly sought.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 2 of Republic Act No. 7432, as amended by Republic 1 2 Act No. 9257, further amended by Republic Act No. 9994, otherwise known as the "Expanded Senior Citizens Act of 2010", is hereby further amended to read 3 as follows: 4 5 "Sec. 2. Sec. 3. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Sec. 4. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, executive orders or rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Sec. 5. Effectivity Clause. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
