EXPANDING THE POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MOVIE AND TELEVISION REVIEW AND CLASSIFICATION BOARD TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF VIDEO GAMES AND OUTDOOR MEDIA, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1986

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Movie and Television Review and Classification Board (MTRCB), established by Presidential Decree No. 1986 in 1985, serves an important role in safeguarding our children from violent, obscene, and otherwise harmful material that may endanger their safety and wellbeing. The ratings published by the MTRCB educate parents about the subject matter discussed and portrayed in these media, empowering them to make informed decisions about the kind of media to which they wish to expose their children. This is certainly a worthy undertaking that has been duly accomplished by the MTRCB for almost 30 years now.

However, the mandate of this Board, delineated well before the proliferation of affordable and accessible computer technology, does not cover another potent type of visual media - video games. Since the late 19908 many countries have expanded the functions and powers of their respective movie and television regulatory bodies to include the review and classification of video games, owing to the increasingly dominant position of video games in visual entertainment worldwide. These regulatory bodies have also focused on ensuring that video games with mature themes do not fall into the hands of those too young to properly process the graphic and violent scenes they are controlling on the screen.

According to the 2009 Nielsen Global Online Consumer Survey, Filipinos are the top consumers of video games in the entire world. In order to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our children, working hand-in-hand with the responsible and nurturing parents and guardians of our great Nation, it is paramount that we upgrade the bureaucracy in the face of new technologies and changing times. Thus, this legislation aims to reorganize the MTRCB into a more versatile body up-to-date with the needs of contemporary Philippine society.

In addition to video games, this legislation also gives MTRCB regulatory powers over the content of outdoor media. Realistically, it is virtually impossible to restrict access of minors to outdoor media since by definition they are prominently displayed in public spaces. Thus, in order to further protect the safety and well-being of our children we must take steps to ensure that obscene outdoor media will be prohibited as necessary. Since the functions of MTRCB already include the review of certain publicity materials, it is logical to delegate the review of outdoor media to this body as well.

Support for the passage and approval of this legislation is earnestly sought.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title, - This Act shall be known as the "Video Game
 and Outdoor Media Regulation Act".

3 SEC. 2. *Paragraphs* 1 and 2 of Section 2 regarding Composition, 4 *Qualifications, and Benefits are hereby amended to read as follows:*

The Board shall be composed of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman 5 and [thirty (30) members] THIRTY-FIVE (35) MEMBERS, who 6 7 shall all be appointed by the President of the Philippines. The Chairman, the Vice-Chairman, and the members of the Board, 8 shall hold office for a term of one (1) year, unless sooner 9 removed by the President for any cause; Provided, That they 10 11 shall be eligible for re-appointment after the expiration of their term. If the Chairman, or the Vice-Chairman or any member of 12

the Board fails to complete his term, any person appointed to
 fill the vacancy shall serve only for the unexpired portion of the
 term of the Board member whom he succeeds.

4 No person shall be appointed to the Board, unless he is a 5 natural-born citizen of the Philippines, not less than twenty-one (21) years of age, and of good moral character and standing in the 6 community; Provided, That in the selection of the members 7 8 of the Board due consideration shall be given to such 9 qualifications as would produce a multi-sectoral combination of expertise in the various areas of motion picture, VIDEO 10 GAMES, OUTDOOR MEDIA, and television; Provided, further, 11 That at least five (5) members of the BOARD shall be members 12 13 of the Philippine Bar; Provided, [finally] FURTHER, That at least fifteen (15) members of the Board may come from the 14 movie and television industry to be nominated by legitimate 15 associations representing the various sectors of said industry, 16 17 PROVIDED, FINALLY, THAT AT LEAST FIVE (5) MEMBERS 18 OF THE BOARD MAY COME FROM VIDEO GAME AND 19 OUTDOOR MEDIA INDUSTRIES TO BE NOMINATED BY LEGITIMATE ASSOCIATIONS REPRESENTING 20 THE VARIOUS SECTORS OF SAID INDUSTRY. 21

22 SEC. 3. Section 3 regarding Powers and Functions is hereby 23 amended to read as follows:

24 a)XXX

25 b) To screen, review and examine all motion pictures, VIDEO GAMES, AND OUTDOOR MEDIA as herein defined, television 26 27 programs, including publicity materials such as 28 advertisements, trailers and stills, whether such motion 29 pictures and publicity materials be for theatrical or non-30 theatrical distribution, for television broadcast or for general 31 viewing, imported or produced in the Philippines, and in the

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1 *latter case, whether they be for local viewing or for export;*

c) To approve or disapprove, delete objectionable portions from 2 and/ or prohibit the importation, exportation, production, 3 copying, distribution, sale, lease, exhibition and/ or television 4 broadcast of the motion pictures, VIDEO GAMES, television 5 programs, OUTDOOR MEDIA, and publicity materials subject 6 of the preceding paragraph, which, in the judgment of the 7 applying contemporary Filipino cultural 8 board values as 9 standard, are objectionable for being immoral, indecent, contrary to law and/ or good customs, injurious to the prestige 10 of the Republic of the Philippines or its people, or with a 11 dangerous tendency to encourage the commission of violence 12 or of wrong or crime, such as but not limited to: 13

To supervise, regulate, and grant, deny or cancel, permits for 20 21 the importation, exportation, production, copying, distribution, 22 sale, lease, exhibition, and/ or television broadcast of all pictures, VIDEO GAMES, television 23 motion programs, OUTDOOR MEDIA and publicity materials, to the end that no 24 25 such pictures, programs and materials as are determined by the Board to be objectionable in accordance with paragraph (c) 26 hereof shall imported, 27 be exported, produced, copied, distributed, leased, 28 reproduced, sold, exhibited and/ or broadcast by television; 29

To supervise, regulate, and grant, deny or cancel, permits for the importation, exportation, production, copying, distribution, sale, lease, exhibition, and/or television broadcast of all motion pictures, VIDEO

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GAMES, television programs, OUTDOOR MEDIA and publicity materials as are determined by the Board to be objectionable in accordance with paragraph (c) hereof shall be importer, exported, produced, copied, reproduced, distributed, sold, leased, exhibited and/or broadcast by television;

VIDEO GAMES, d)TO classify motion pictures, television 6 7 programs and similar shows into categories such as "G" or "For General Patronage" (all ages admitted), "P" or "Parental 8 Guidance Suggested", "R~ or "Resin ted" (for adults only), "X" 9 or "Not for Public Viewing", or such other categories as the 10 BOARD may determine for the public interest; 11

- e) To close movie houses and other similar establishments
 engaged in the public exhibition of motion pictures and
 television programs, OR THE SALE AND|OR DISTRIBUTION
 OF VIDEO GAMES, which violate the provisions of this Act
 and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Board
 pursuant hereto;

g) To deputize representatives from the government and from 19 the various associations in the movie, VIDEO GAME, 20 AND OUTDOOR MEDIA *[industry]* INDUSTRIES, 21 whose main duties shall be to help ensure compliance 22 with all laws 23 relative to the importation, exportation, copying, distribution, sale, exhibition and/ or television broadcast of 24 lease, motion advertisements and publicity 25 pictures, television programs, materials. For this purpose, the Board may constitute such 26 Regulatory Council or Councils composed of representatives 27 28 from the government and the movie and television industry as may be appropriate to implement the purposes and objectives 29 of this Act. The Board may also call on any law enforcement 30 agency for assistance in the implementation and enforcement 31 of its decisions, orders or awards; 32

h) To cause the prosecution, on behalf of the People of the
Philippines, of violators of this Act, of anti-trust, obscenity,
censorship and other laws pertinent to the movie, VIDEO
GAME, OUTDOOR MEDIA and television [industry]
INDUSTRIES;

8 SEC. 4. *Section 4 regarding Decision is amended by inserting the* 9 *following paragraph:*

THE PROCEDURES USED BY THE BOARD TO IMPLEMENT 10 FUNCTIONS AND MAKE DECI.SIONS ITS REVIEW 11 CONCERNING THE APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL OF A 12 13 MOTION PICTURE OR TELEVISION, INCLUDING APPELLATE PROCEDURES, SHALL ALSO BE USED FOR THE REVIEW 14 OF VIDEO GAMES AND OUTDOOR MEDIA AS APPLICABLE 15 UNDER THIS ACT. 16

NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF OTHER 3 APPLICABLE LAWS, A MINOR THAT MAKES USE OF ANY 4 FALSE EVIDENCE ABOUT HIS OR HER AGE TO OBTAIN A 5 GAME SHALL BE COPY OF THE VIDEO PUNISHED 6 THE PROVISIONS 7 PURSUANT TO ON PENALTIES STIPULATED BY SECTION 11 OF THIS ACT. 8

9 SEC. 7. Section 8 regarding Posting or Display of Certificate or 10 Label is amended by inserting the following paragraph:

THE PACKAGING OF ANY VIDEO GAME AND ANY PRINTED OR 11 12 DIGITAL PUBLICITY MATERIAL, WHETHER LOCALLY-PRODUCED OR IMPORTED, THAT IS SOLD AND/OR DISTRIBUTED IN THE 13 PHILIPPINES MUST DISPLAY ITS RATING AS ASSIGNED BY THE 14 BOARD IN AN EASILY-VIEWABLE, LEGIBLE MANNER ON THE FRONT 15 SIDE IN THE STYLE AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD. 16 DIGITAL COPIES OF GAMES MUST DISPLAY 17 THE RATING LABEL ON THE MENU SCREEN. 18

REFERS TO MEDIA ALL EXISTING AND 13 12.0UTDOOR -PROPOSED **ADVERTISING** SIGNS, BILLBOARDS, DISPLAY 14 SIGNS, ELECTRICAL SIGNS, LIGHT EMITTING DIODE 15 (LED) BILLBOARDS, GROUND SIGNS, ROOF 16 SIGNS AND SIGNS, AND SIGN STRUCTURES ALONG MAJOR THOROUGHFARES, PUBLIC 17 ROADS, SECONDARY ROADS, AVENUES, STREETS, ROADS, PARKS 18 AND OPEN SPACES WITHIN METRO MANILA AND OTHER CITIES AND 19 MUNICIPALITIES. 20

25THE PROCEDURE FOLLOWED CONCERNING THE BANNING OF26MOTION PICTURES AND TELEVISION PROGRAMS SHALL ALSO APPLY27TO CASES IN WHICH VIDEO GAMES OR OUTDOOR MEDIA ARE28DEEMED BY THE BOARD, AFTER EXAMINATION AND REVIEW, TO BE29UNFIT FOR CONSUMPTION IN THE PHILIPPINES.

30 SEC. 10. *Implementing Rules and Regulations. -* Within (60) days 31 from the effectivity of this Act, the Board shall promulgate the implementing 32 rules and regulations as may be necessary to ensure the efficient and effective 33 implementation of this Act.

34 SEC. 11. *Separability Clause.* - Should any part of this Act be declared 35 unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions of this Act shall continue to be in 36 effect and subsisting.

37 SEC. 12. *Amendatory Clause.* - The pertinent provisions of P.D. No.

1 1986, in so far as they are inconsistent herewith, are hereby expressly 2 amended or modified accordingly.

3 SEC. 13. *Repealing Clause.* - The provisions of other laws, decrees, 4 executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby 5 repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

6 SEC. 14. *Effectivity Clause.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days 7 after its publication in the *Official Gazette* and/or in at least two (2) national 8 newspapers in general circulation.
