RESOLUTION URGING THE EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT TO EXPEDITE THE RETURN TO SOUTH KOREA OF THE ILLEGALLY IMPORTED PLASTIC WASTES IN MINDANAO

WHEREAS, a shipment from South Korea declared as "plastic synthetic flakes" arrived at the Mindanao Container Terminal (MCT) in Tagoloan, Misamis Oriental on board MV Affluent Ocean in July 2018;

WHEREAS, it was discovered in November 2018 that the shipment actually contained tons of plastic wastes, wood, and other materials (the "South Korea trash") instead of the declared plastic synthetic flakes;

WHEREAS, Section 1400 of Republic Act No. 10863 or the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act heavily punishes misdeclaration or misclassification of goods with 250% of the duty and tax due and when the same is intentional or fraudulent, a 500% surcharge shall be imposed on the importer or person(s) who willfully participated in the fraudulent act;

WHEREAS, in November 2018, *Proposed Senate Resolution No.* 939 was filed in the Senate, to conduct an inquiry in aid of legislation, on the reported importation of plastic wastes from South Korea;

WHEREAS, as a solution to this, a Bilateral Agreement between Philippines and South Korea to have the bulk wastes repatriated to its country of origin, was held in December 2018, and the South Korean Government agreed that they shall start shipping the bulk wastes, in

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2019, 1,400 tons of waste were returned to South Korea, while the rest, were supposedly to be shipped back by the end of that month;

WHEREAS, despite the agreement between the Philippines and the South Korean Government to take back to South Korea all of the said illegally shipped waste matter, about 5,177 tons of trash still remain in the country;

WHEREAS, our country appears to be heading towards the path of the so-called "global waste trade", and the government has to act swiftly to ensure that the Philippines is prevented from being a dumping site of other countries;

WHEREAS, the undersigned, filed *Senate Bill No. 98* or "An Act Banning the Importation of Solid Waste" on July 1, 2019, to prohibit and prevent incidents of trash dumping by foreign countries to the Philippines;

WHEREAS, protecting and advancing the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology is a Constitutional duty and an intergenerational responsibility;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, as a matter of paramount public interest, to urge the Executive Department to expedite the return to South Korea of the illegally shipped plastic wastes in Mindanao, with the end in view of preventing the Philippines from being a dumping site of other countries, in this so-called "global waste trade".
