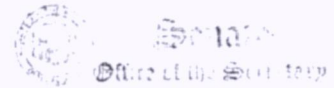

**A RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CARLOS YULO FOR BAGGING THE
COUNTRY'S FIRST GOLD MEDAL IN THE WORLD ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS
CHAMPIONSHIPS IN GERMANY**

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo captured the first gold medal of the country at the World Artistic Gymnastics Championships on October 12, 2019 at Stuttgart, Germany;

WHEREAS, Yulo, the youngest competitor at the age of 19, topped the men's floor exercise gaining a final score of 15.300;

WHEREAS, this is the first time that the country has received a gold medal in the World Artistic Gymnastics Championships;

WHEREAS, Yulo was also the first Filipino to land on the podium in the World Artistic Gymnastics Championships held in Doha, Qatar last year;

WHEREAS, this victory has qualified the young athlete to the 2020 Tokyo Olympics;

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo's passion, perseverance and hard work continues to serve as an inspiration to all budding athletes and to all Filipinos;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Philippines congratulate and commend Carlos Yulo for bringing honor and recognition to the nation by winning the country's first gold medal in the World Artistic Gymnastics Championships held in Stuttgart, Germany.
