RESOLUTION
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING CARLOS EDRIEL YULO FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL FOR THE MEN'S FLOOR EXERCISES AT THE 49TH FIG ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP IN STUTTGART, GERMANY

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has always recognized and commended exemplary Filipinos and their contribution in showcasing our nation's potential in various disciplines of Sports and in any Filipino bringing honor and pride to the country by competing and winning in international competitions;

WHEREAS, during the 2019 FIG Artistic Gymnastics Championship in Stuttgart, Germany, held last October 12, 2019, gymnast Carlos Edriel Yulo attained the Philippines' first gold medal in artistic gymnastics;

WHEREAS, Carlos Yulo bested Artem Dolgopyat of Israel, who ranked 2nd, followed by Ruoteng Xiao of China who clinched the 3rd spot, to become the first Gymnast from Southeast Asia to win a gold medal in the World Championship;

WHEREAS, truly a historic first for Philippine gymnastics, doing our country proud, and the whole gymnastic community of the Philippines while also securing his participation in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics;

WHEREAS, this significant win by Yulo is a testament to the potential of Filipinos in sports around the world, this should serve as a wake-up call for our government to provide more support to our athletes who represent our great nation across the world through Sports.

WHEREAS, the Senate salutes the pure determination and raw talent Carlos Yulo displayed throughout the competition, this achievement has not only made our country proud but it has proven to the world that we are not hindered by our genetic makeup and it has shown our capacity for excellence in gymnastics;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for the Senate of the Philippines to commend gymnast Carlos Edriel Yulo for winning the gold medal for the men's floor exercises during the 2019 World Artistic Gymnastics Championships held last October 12, 2019 in Stuttgart, Germany.

- 12 1. Carlos Yulo won a gold medal in the 2019 World Artistic Gymnastics
13 Championships (Gymnastics - Artistic Gymnastics);
 - 14 2. Hidilyn Diaz won a bronze medal in the 2019 IWF World Championship
15 (Weightlifting 55kg Women); and silver medal in the 2019 Asian
16 Weightlifting Championship (Weightlifting 55kg Women);
 - 17 3. Eumir Felix Marcial won a silver medal in AIBA World Boxing
18 Championship (Boxing 75kg);
 - 19 4. Nesthy Petecio won a gold medal in the 2019 AIBA Women's World
20 Boxing Championships (Boxing-Featherweight);

- 1 5. John Ernest Obiena won a gold medal in the 23rd Asian Athletics
2 Championships (Pole Vault) and 30th Summer Universiade 2019 (Pole
3 Vault);
