

RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING CARLOS EDRIEL YULO FOR
WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE 2019 WORLD ARTISTIC GYMNASTIC
CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN STUTTGART, GERMANY

- 1 **WHEREAS**, the 1987 Constitution dictates that the State recognizes the vital role of
2 sports in fostering patriotism and nationalism, accelerating social progress and
3 promoting total human liberation and development;
- 4 **WHEREAS**, the nineteen (19) year old Carlos Edriel Yulo has successfully managed
5 to capture the Philippines' first historic gold medal in the men's floor exercise of the
6 Fédération Internationale de Gymnastique (FIG) 2019 World Artistic Gymnastic
7 Championships, last October 12, 2019, in Stuttgart, Germany;
- 8 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino gymnast emerged victorious as he defeated Israel's Artem
9 Dolgopyat (15.200), who ranked 2nd, and China's Ruoteng Xiao (14.933) placing 3rd; in
10 the 2019 World Artistic Gymnastics Championships, obtaining our first ever gold in
11 any gymnastics discipline, and the first Southeast Asian to win such an award;
- 12 **WHEREAS**, his triumphant feat made allowed him to qualify and compete at the
13 world's grandest sporting event, the 2020 Tokyo Olympics;
- 14 **WHEREAS**, the Philippines has been constantly producing world-renowned talents
15 who exemplify the true Filipino spirit of competitiveness in the field of sports;
- 16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the
17 Senate, to commend and congratulate Carlos Edriel Yulo for winning the gold medal
18 in the 2019 World Artistic Gymnastic Championships held in Stuttgart, Germany.
