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**AN ACT**  
**AMENDING SECTION 65 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11260, OTHERWISE KNOWN**  
**AS THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF FISCAL YEAR 2019**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The General Appropriations Act for fiscal years 2014 to 2017 consistently provided that the appropriations for Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlays (CO) were available for release and obligations for a period extending to one (1) fiscal year after the fiscal year in which said items were appropriated.

In fiscal year 2018, Joint Resolution No. 3 was adopted extending the availability of the 2018 appropriations for MOOE and CO to December 31, 2019, amending for the purpose Section 61 of the General Provisions of Republic Act No. 10964, the General Appropriations Act of Fiscal Year 2018.

The late passage of the 2019 General Appropriations Act and the election ban on the implementation of infrastructure projects and social services in view of the May 13, 2019 National and Local Elections resulted in the delay of the implementation of infrastructure projects and basic social services.

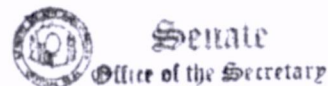
There are appropriations that have not been released and allotment issued that have not been obligated which shall automatically lapse depriving the people and the country of the much-needed MOOE and CO to fund priority projects, financial assistance program, aid, and relief activities as well as for the maintenance, construction/repair, and rehabilitation of schools, hospitals, roads, bridges and other essential facilities of the national government.

The President, under Section 5 of Executive Order No. 91, mandated the implementation of an operational cash budget for Fiscal Year 2019 which requires that all appropriations should be obligated by December 31, 2019 but allows the implementation of and payment for MOOE, as well as other CO, and infrastructure projects to extend until June 30, 2020, and December 31, 2020, respectively.

It is therefore necessary that Section 65 of the General Provisions of Republic Act No. 11260 should be amended such that the validity of the MOOE and CO appropriations be extended for another fiscal year for the benefit of the people and for the welfare of the nation.

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**AMENDING SECTION 65 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11260, OTHERWISE KNOWN**  
**AS THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF FISCAL YEAR 2019**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **Section 1.** Section 65 of the General Provisions of Republic Act No. 11260 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "SEC. 65. Availability of Appropriations. All appropriations authorized  
4 in this Act shall be available for release and obligation for the  
5 purpose specified, and under the same special provisions applicable  
6 thereto, until [~~December 31, 2019~~] **DECEMBER 31, 2020.**

7 A report on these releases and obligations shall be submitted to  
8 the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the  
9 Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations  
10 and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by  
11 way of electronic document."

12 **Section 2. *Repealing Clause.*** Republic Act No. 11260, and all laws, decrees, executive  
13 orders, letters of instructions and regulations or any part thereof which are inconsistent  
14 with any provision of this Act are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

15 **Section 3. *Effectivity.*** This Act shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following its  
16 publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation of in the Official  
17 Gazette.
