RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE OUTSTANDING WOMEN IN THE NATION'S SERVICE (TOWNS) 2019 FOR THEIR POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION AND DEDICATION IN STRENGTHENING NATION BUILDING

1 WHEREAS, The Outstanding Women in the Nation's Service (TOWNS) is a 2 triennial search initiated by Towns Foundation, Inc. to identify Filipino women who 3 made exceptional contributions for the betterment of the society;

WHEREAS, the TOWNS award is given to Filipino women aged 21-50 years old and have used their influence in shaping the country's economic, social and cultural development, women empowerment, national security and national unity;

WHEREAS, since its formation in 1974, the TOWNS has named 166 inspiring
Filipino women. The award is given every three years, after a year of a nationwide
deliberation and is held during the last week of October;

10 WHEREAS, the 12 TOWNS awardees for 2019 came from diverse sectors – 11 Arts, Humanities, Education, Science and Technology, Health, Law and Peace 12 Advocacy;

Regina Justina Estuar for Science and Technology, Carmina Bayombong for Entrepreneurship, Geraldine Zamora for Health, Patricia Ann Prodigalidad for Law, and Samira Gutoc for Peace Advocacy: Now, therefore, be it
