## Introduced by Senator JOEL VILLANUEVA

## RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING THE PHILIPPINE CONTINGENT FOR ITS OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE IN THE 2019 SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES

WHEREAS, From 30<sup>th</sup> November till the 11<sup>th</sup> of December 2019, the 1,115 athletes and 753 coaches and staff from the Philippine contingent competed across 56 sports in the 30<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian Games held in several parts of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, With 149 gold, 117 silver and 121 bronze medals, the 387-medalled Philippine contingent emerged as the overall champion during the 30<sup>th</sup> Sea Games even breaking its record of 2005 Sea Games where the Philippines bagged a total of 290 medals with 112 gold medals;

WHEREAS, The Philippine contingent continues to set records in the 30<sup>th</sup> Sea Games with the Philippine National Team for Arnis bagging 14 gold medals – the most from any team; Gymnastics star Carlos Yulo becoming the most bemedalled Filipino athlete with two gold and five silver medals; Kristina Knott setting a new Sea Games record in women's 200 meters; the men's volleyball team setting a historic finish after reaching the gold medal round for the first time in 42 years; and the Gilas Pilipinas men and women basketball teams becoming undefeated in the 5x5 game, and giving the women's basketball 5x5 team its first-ever gold medal;

WHEREAS, the victory and outstanding performance of the Philippine contingent in the 30<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian Games is a testament of the world class talent of the Filipino;

**RESOLVE BY THE SENATE**, that the Senate of the Philippines recognizes and commends the victory of the entire Philippine contingent in the 30<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian Games.
