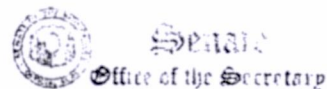




**A RESOLUTION  
CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING ALEX EALA FOR WINNING FIRST  
JUNIORS GRAND SLAM TITLE IN 2020 AUSTRALIAN OPEN**

**WHEREAS**, Alex Eala won the juniors Grand Slam title with Indonesian partner Priska Nugroho in the 2020 Australia Open juniors doubles tournament on January 31, 2020 in Melbourne Park, Melbourne, Australia;

**WHEREAS**, the team overpowered United Kingdom's Matilda Mutavdzic and Slovenia's Ziva Falkner;

**WHEREAS**, the 14-year old Eala is the first Filipino to win a juniors Grand Slam since 2009 when Francis Casey Alcantara also captured the Australian Open boys doubles title with Hsieh Cheng-peng of Chinese Taipei;

**WHEREAS**, after securing the grand slam title, the Rafael Nadal Academy scholar clinched No. 4 in the International Tennis Federation juniors world ranking with 1718.75 points;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Senate of the Philippines congratulate and commend Alex Eala for bringing honor and recognition to the Philippines by winning the junior Grand Slam title with doubles Indonesian partner Priska Nugroho in the 2020 Australian Open juniors tournament on January 31, 2020 in Melbourne Park, Melbourne, Australia.
