RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF THE SENATE TO JOIN THE COMMUNITY OF MEMBER STATES OF THE UNITED NATIONS IN THE CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY 2020

WHEREAS, International Women's Day is celebrated in many countries around 1 the world. It is a day when women are recognized for their achievements without 2 regard to divisions, whether national, ethnic, linguistic, cultural, economic or 3 political¹; 4

WHEREAS, International Women's Day first emerged from the activities of labor movements at the turn of the twentieth century in North America and across Europe²;

WHEREAS, in 1975 during the International Women's Year, the United Nations began celebrating International Women's Day on 8 March³;

WHEREAS, the theme for International Women's Day (8 March) 2020 is, I am Generation Equality: Realizing Women's Rights⁴;

WHEREAS, The theme is aligned with UN Women's new multigenerational campaign, Generation Equality, which marks the 25th anniversary of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action⁵;
