

AN ACT

PROHIBITING THE USE OF WORDS THAT WOULD DENOTE RELIGIOUS, REGIONAL OR ETHNIC AFFILIATION IN PRINT, RADIO, TELEVISION INCLUDING CABLE TELEVISION AND OTHER FORMS OF BROADCAST MEDIA TO REFER TO OR DESCRIBE ANY PERSON SUSPECTED OR CONVICTED OF A CRIME OR UNLAWFUL ACT AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. *Prohibited Act.* – It is hereby declared unlawful for any person to use the words that would denote religious, regional or ethnic affiliation in print, radio, television, including cable television and/or any form of broadcast media to refer to or describe any person suspected of or convicted of a crime or any unlawful act.

Sec. 2. *Penalties.* – The penalty of *arresto mayor* or a fine ranging from One thousand pesos (Php 1,000.00) to Ten thousand pesos (Php 10,000.00) or both, at the discretion of the court, shall be imposed upon any person found guilty of violating Section 1 hereof.

Sec. 3. *Separability Clause.* – If for any reason any section or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

1	Sec. 4. Repealing Clause. – All laws, orders, rules and regulations or parts
2	thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

4	Sec. 5. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
5	publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
