The Committees on Health and Demography, and Finance, to which was referred House Bill No. 6218, introduced by Representatives Bautista-Bandigan, Duterte, Garcia, et. al. entitled:

**AN ACT
RENAMING THE MALITA DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN BARANGAY
POBLACION, MUNICIPALITY OF MALITA, PROVINCE OF DAVAO
OCCIDENTAL TO MALITA WOMEN'S AND CHILDREN'S WELLNESS
CENTER**

have considered the same and have the honor to report back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 6218 be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 2, after line 9, insert two new Sections:

**"SEC. 6. IF ANY PROVISION OR PART OF THIS ACT IS DECLARED
UNCONSTITUTIONAL, THE REMAINING PARTS OR PROVISIONS NOT
AFFECTED SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT."**


"SEC. 7. ALL LAWS, EXECUTIVE ORDERS, ISSUANCES, RULES AND REGULATIONS INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ACT ARE HEREBY REPEALED OR MODIFIED ACCORDINGLY."





AN ACT RENAMING THE MALITA DISTRICT HOSPITAL IN
BARANGAY POBLACION, MUNICIPALITY OF MALITA,
PROVINCE OF DAVAO OCCIDENTAL TO MALITA WOMEN'S
AND CHILDREN'S WELLNESS CENTER

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Malita District Hospital located in Barangay
2 Poblacion, Municipality of Malita, Province of Davao Occidental is
3 hereby renamed the Malita Women's and Children's Wellness
4 Center.

5 SEC. 2. The Malita Women's and Children's Wellness Center,
6 hereinafter referred to as the Center, shall provide specialty
7 healthcare services on obstetrics and gynecology, prenatal, postnatal,
8 and neonatal care, lactation programs, children's immunization,
9 other women and pediatric care and animal bite treatment.

1 SEC. 3. The Center shall be under the direct supervision and
2 control of the Provincial Government of Davao Occidental.

3 SEC. 4. The Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH)
4 shall immediately include in the Department's subsidy program, its
5 support for the capital outlays requirement of the Center.

6 SEC. 5. The Chief of Hospital shall submit to the DOH a
7 development plan to reflect the developmental goals of the Center.
8 The medical personnel, capital outlays and budgetary needs for the
9 operation of the Center shall be based on its development plan.

10 SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
11 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
12 circulation.
