MINIMUM HEIGHT THE AN ACT LOWERING **APPLICANTS** OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP), BUREAU OF (BFP), BUREAU JAIL OF FIRE PROTECTION PENOLOGY (BJMP), AND MANAGEMENT AND BUREAU OF CORRECTION (BUCOR), AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6975, AS AMENDED, REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9263, AND REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10575, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PNP,

2 BFP, BJMP and BuCor Height Equality Act".

1	SEC. 2. Section 30 of Republic Act No. 6975, as
2	amended, is further amended to read as follows:

"j) XXX... 5 "After the lapse of the time period for the 6 satisfaction of a specific requirement, current 7 members of the PNP who will fail to satisfy any of 8 9 the requirements enumerated under this Section shall be separated from the service if they are 10 below fifty (50) years of age and have served in 11 Government for less than twenty (20) years or 12 retired if they are from the age of fifty (50) and 13 above and have served the Government for at least 14 twenty (20) years without prejudice in either case 15 to the payment of benefits they may be entitled to 16 under existing laws." 17

18 SEC. 3. Section 4 of Republic Act No. 9263, is
19 amended to read as follows:

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"After the lapse of the time of period for 7 the satisfaction of a specific requirement, current 8 uniformed personnel of the BFP and the BJMP 9 who will fail to satisfy any of the requirements 10 under this Section shall be 11 enumerated separated from the service if they are below fifty 12 (50) years of age and have served in the 13 government for less than twenty (20) years, or 14 retired if they are age fifty (50) and above and 15 have served in the government for at least 16 twenty (20) years without prejudice in either 17 case to the payment of benefits they may be 18 entitled to under existing laws." 19

1	SEC. 4. Section 11 of Republic Act No. 10575, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"SEC. 11. Professionalization and Upgrading
4	of Qualification Standards in the Appointment of
5	the BuCor Personnel (a) No person shall be
6	appointed as personnel of the BuCor unless one
7	possesses the following minimum qualifications:

Except for this particular provision, 6 the above-enumerated qualifications shall be 7 continuing in character and an absence of any 8 one of them at any given time shall be ground for 9 from the retirement 10 separation or service: Provided, furthermore, That those who 11 are already in the service upon the effectivity of 12 this Act shall be given five (5) years from the 13 date of such effectivity to obtain the minimum 14 educational qualification and eligibility with 15 subsidiary assistance as provided for in this Act. 16

2	personnel through its Personnel Training School,
3	which shall be renamed as Corrections Training
4	School/Institute patterned after the BJMP's Jail
5	National Training Institute (JNTI), the Bureau
6	of Fire's Fire National Training Institute (FNTI)
7	and the PNP's National Training Institute
8	(PNTI)."

SEC. 5. Implementing Rules and Regulations. -9 Within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act, the 10 PNP, BFP, BJMP and BuCor, in coordination with the 11 Department of the Interior and Local Government, the 12 National Police Commission, the Department of Justice, 13 the Philippine National Police, the Philippine National 14 Police Academy, the Civil Service Commission, and other 15 concerned government agencies and stakeholders shall 16 formulate the necessary rules and regulations for the 17 effective implementation of this Act. 18

SEC. 6. Separability Clause. – If any part, section or 1 provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, 2 the sections or provisions which are not affected shall 3 remain valid and subsisting. 4 SEC. 7. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, 5 ordinances, rules, regulations, other issuances or parts 6 thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby 7 repealed or modified accordingly. 8 SEC. 8. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect 9 fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the 10

11 Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
