

AN ACT

TO RECLASSIFY THE MANGABUL RESERVATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN, INTO ALIENABLE AND DISPOSABLE OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDISTRIBUTING THE SAME TO THE BONAFIDE AND LONG-TERM FARMERS/OCCUPANTS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Located in San Gabriel 2nd, Bayambang, Pangasinan, the 2,059 hectares-area of the Mangabul Reservation was declared by the Bureau of Lands as insular public domain in 1933 by virtue of Act No. 4041. This reservation used to be partly forested and partly a lake. This same Act awarded the usufructuary rights to the town over the fishery area that was referred to as the Mangabul Fishery Reservation.

Over time, the forested fractions of the reservation were converted into agricultural production and the accumulation of silt over the years and the lahar that flowed from the eruption of Mt. Pinatubo has lessened the fishery area into a few shallow creeks during the dry season. Presently, the entire reservation has become farmlands and residential area comprising of eight (8) barangays.

Controversies arose between the farmers and occupants, and the municipality and the lessees of the fishery reservation. These disputes resulted in many civil and criminal cases, but the courts always recognized the right of the farmers to the possession of the lands.

In 1993, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) declared the municipality's usufructuary rights terminated under Article 605 of the Civil Code which disallows usufructuary rights to last in excess of 50 years. When the court

decided in favor of the DENR's claim, the municipality of Bayambang appealed the decision and the case remained pending since.

In order to settle the legal issues and agrarian unrest surrounding this matter, this proposed measure aims to: reclassify the Mangabul Reservation into alienable and disposable land of the public domain, distribute the land ownership to bonafide and long-term farmers and occupants, and grant the usufruct over the remaining creeks in the area to the Municipality of Bayambang, which shall be managed and developed by the farmer-occupants themselves upon payment of reasonable compensation to the municipality.


In view of the foregoing, the early passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

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TO RECLASSIFY THE MANGABUL RESERVATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN, INTO ALIENABLE AND DISPOSABLE OF THE PUBLIC DOMAIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDISTRIBUTING THE SAME TO THE BONAFIDE AND LONG-TERM FARMERS/OCCUPANTS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The timber land comprising the Mangabul Reservation designated by the Bureau of Lands Survey as Insular Public Domain (IPD-92), with an area of 2,333 hectares, more or less, located in the Municipality of Bayambang, Province of Pangasinan, the usufructuary rights over the fishery are of which were granted in 1933 to the said Municipality, is hereby reclassified and declared as alienable and disposable land of the public domain, described as follows:

TECHNICAL DESCRIPTIONS

(LOT 2)

A parcel of Timberland per Land Classification Map No. 698, dated 10 November 21, 1927 of the Department of Environment and Natural 11 Resources located in Barangay Manambong Parte, Manambong Sur, Pugo, 12 Paragos, San Gabriel 1st and San Gabriel 2nd, Municipality of Bayambang, 13 Province of Pangasinan, Island of Luzon under Bayambang Cadastre, Cad. 14 852-D, with a total land area of TWENTY THREE MILLION THREE 15 HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY 16 (23,330,260) SQUARE METERS, more or less, said parcel of land is 17 more particularly described as follows: 18

SEC 2. The aforementioned land shall be distributed in ownership to 8 bonafide and long-term farmers/occupants thereon; but the existing creeks in 9 the same area shall be given the usufruct to the Municipality of Bayambang, 10 Provided, that the said bonafide and long-term farmers/occupants shall manage 11 and develop the said creeks upon payment by them of reasonable compensation 12 to said Municipality. 13

SEC 3. The scheme of distribution of the land, including the identities of 14 the bona fide and long-term farmers/occupants thereon, shall be prepared by a 15 Committee which shall be composed of the following: the representative of the 16 Department of Environment and Natural Resources as Chairman; the 17 representative of the Department of Agrarian Reform as Vice-Chairman; and the 18 Mayor of Bayambang, the Head of the farmer's organization, and the Provincial 19 Director of the Philippine National Police, as members. The scheme of 20 distribution shall include the technical description of each lot pertaining to each 21 of the farmers/occupants, following the boundaries of existing integrated social 22 forestry stewardship and/or similar contracts that may have been awarded in 23 their favor; Provided, that said scheme of distribution shall be as equitable as 24 possible without gross disparities among the awardees. 25

Conflicts shall be decided by the Committee after due hearing, appealable 26 to the Department Secretary under whose jurisdiction the issue involve falls. The 27 Secretary's decision or order on appeal may be subject of a petition for review 28 by the Office of the President within fifteen (15) days from promulgation of 29 notice of the decision or order appealed from; Provided, that said petition for 30 review shall be decided within thirty (30 days after receipt thereof, otherwise, 31 the decision or order appealed from shall be deemed ratified and final. 32

SEC 4. Once the scheme of distribution is approved by the Committee, 33 the Department of Environment and Natural Resources shall give the technical 34 description, survey maps, and similar documents to the DAR, which shall 35 undertake the actual distribution of the land under the principles of agrarian 36 reform and the applicable provisions of the Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Law 37 and other related laws. 38

SEC 5. The existing creeks in the area shall be plotted, surveyed and 39 segregated from the other portions of the area by the DENR, and shall be given 40 in usufruct to the Municipality of Bayambang. The Mayor and the Head of the 41 organization of the farmer's beneficiaries shall meet to discuss and determine 42 the reasonable compensation to be paid to the Municipality for the Management 43 and development thereof by said beneficiaries. In case of disagreement, the 44 Regional Director of DENR Regional Office shall decide. 45

SEC 6. Repealing Clause. - Act No. 4041 is hereby repealed, and all 46 other laws, executive and administrative orders, rules and regulations 47 inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly. 48

1 **SEC 7.** *Separability Clause.* - If, for any reason, any section of this Act 2 shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions 3 hereof shall not be affected and shall thereby remain in force and in effect.

4 **SEC. 8.** *Effectivity.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its 5 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
