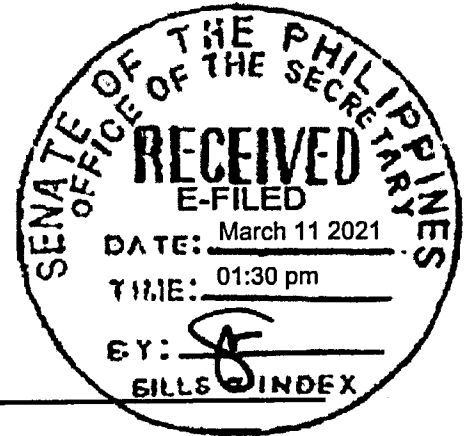





**AN ACT CLASSIFYING THE SAN FERNANDO BYPASS ROAD
AND SAN FERNANDO BYPASS EXTENSION ROAD IN
THE PROVINCE OF LA UNION, INTO NATIONAL ROADS
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The San Fernando Bypass Road and the San
2 Fernando Bypass Extension Road in the Province of La Union
3 are hereby classified as national roads.
- 4 SEC. 2. The San Fernando Bypass Road shall consist of the
5 4.455 kilometer road starting from Km. 266 + 578 to Km. 271 + 033,
6 San Fernando Bypass Channel "A" starting from Km. 266 + 612 to
7 Km. 266 + 647, and the San Fernando Bypass Channel "B" starting
8 from Km. 279 + 407 to Km. 270 + 468. Likewise, the San Fernando
9 Bypass Road Extension shall consist of the 4.769 kilometer road
10 starting from Km. 269 + 585 to Km. 274 + 354, the San Fernando
11 Bypass Road Extension Channel "A" starting from Km. 269 + 880 to
12 Km. 270 + 226, and the San Fernando Bypass Road Extension
13 Channel "B" starting from Km. 274 + 301 to Km. 274 + 333.

1 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Public Works and Highways
2 shall include in the Department's program the improvement,
3 maintenance and repair of the said roads, the funding of which shall
4 be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

5 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
6 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general
7 circulation.
