AN ACT RESETTING THE FIRST REGULAR  
ELECTIONS IN THE BANGSAMORO  
AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO,  
AMENDING, FOR THE PURPOSE, SECTION 13,  
ARTICLE XVI OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11054,  
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE “ORGANIC LAW  
FOR THE BANGSAMORO AUTONOMOUS REGION  
IN MUSLIM MINDANAO”, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of  
the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 13, Article XVI of Republic Act  
2   No. 11054, otherwise known as “Organic Law for the  
3   Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao” is  
4   hereby amended to read as follows:

1                   “SEC. 13. *First Regular Election.* – The  
2                   first regular election for the Bangsamoro  
3                   Government under this Organic Law shall be  
4                   held and synchronized with the 2025 national  
5                   elections. The Commission on Elections, through  
6                   the Bangsamoro Electoral Office, shall  
7                   promulgate rules and regulations for the  
8                   conduct of the elections, enforce and administer  
9                   them pursuant to national laws, this Organic  
10                  Law and the Bangsamoro Electoral Code.”

11                SEC. 2. Upon the expiration of the terms of the  
12                incumbent members of the Bangsamoro Transition  
13                Authority (BTA), the President shall appoint the eighty  
14                (80) members of the said BTA who shall serve up to June  
15                30, 2025 or until their successors shall have been elected.

16                SEC. 3. If any of the provisions of this Act is held  
17                unconstitutional, provisions not affected shall remain valid  
18                and binding.

1           SEC. 4. All laws, decrees, and all other issuances or  
2 parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Act, are  
3 hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

4           SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days  
5 after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or in  
6 at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation.
