AN ACT

RATIONALIZING THE DISABILITY PENSION OF VETERANS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6948, ENTITLED, "AN ACT STANDARDIZING AND UPGRADING THE BEENFITS FOR MILITARY VETERANS AND THEIR BENEFICIARIES," AS AMENDED

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 7, Article XVI of the 1987 Constitution states that the State shall provide immediate and adequate care, benefits, and other forms of assistance to war veterans and veterans of military campaigns, their surviving spouses and orphans.

Pursuant to such mandate, Republic Act No. 6948 was enacted on April 9, 1990 to provide, among others, disability pension to veterans, who have been disabled due to sickness, disease, wounds, or injuries sustained in the line of duty, as well as to their spouses and unmarried minor children. Subsequently, it was amended in 1994 through Republic Act No. 7696 which adjusted the rates of such pension.

Unfortunately, since the enactment of Republic Act No. 7696 and despite the rising standards of living that sustained over time following economic downturns brought about by a series of global financial crisis, and the economic and social consequences of the current COVID-19 pandemic, these disability rates for our veterans have not been increased yet, rendering these amounts negligible and


ineffectual in covering the medical and hospitalization expenses as well as living expenses of these veterans.

In recognition of the patriotic service and sacrifices of these veterans, this bill seeks to increase and rationalize disability pension rates of these veterans, their spouses and beneficiaries. It shall provide an increase in the monthly disability pension of veterans with the following service connected disability rating:

It also provides (1) an increase the additional monthly disability pension for spouses and each unmarried minor children of veterans with service connected disability rating from 91% to 100% to One Thousand pesos (P1,000) from Five hundred pesos (P500.00), (2) entitlement of a veteran without a service-connected disability to a monthly pension of One thousand seven hundred pesos (P1,700.00) upon reaching the age of seventy (70), and (3) that entitlement to the Disability Pension shall be limited to eligible living veterans only.

In view of the foregoing, early passage of this bill is sought.



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Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section 5 of Republic Act No. 6948, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 5. *Pension Rates.* – A veteran who is disabled owing to sickness, disease, wounds or injuries sustained in line of duty shall be given a monthly disability pension in accordance with the rates prescribed hereunder[, unless he is actually receiving a similar pension for the same disability from other government funds or from the United States Government];

"a) If and while the disability is rated anywhere from ten to thirty per centum (10% – 30%) the monthly pension shall be [One thousand pesos (P1,000.00)] FOUR THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP 4,500.00);

pesos (P500.00)] ONE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 1,000.00)		
for the spouse and each unmarried minor children: Provided,		
That a veteran, [with or] without a service-connected [or non-		
service connected] disability, upon reaching the age of seventy		
(70) is deemed totally disabled [with one hundred per centum		
(100%) rating] and shall be entitled to a monthly pension of One		
thousand seven hundred pesos (P1,700.00) ONLY; [plus Five		
hundred pesos (P500.00) for the spouse and each unmarried		
minor children.] PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT THE		
ENTITLEMENT TO THE DISABILITY PENSION		
AUTHORIZED HEREIN SHALL BE PROSPECTIVE AND		
LIMITED TO ELIGIBLE LIVING VETERANS ONLY."		

Section 2. *Appropriations*. The initial amount necessary for the implementation of this Act shall be charged against the current year's available appropriations of the Philippine Veterans Office. Thereafter, such sums as may be needed for the continued implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

Section 3. *Separability Clause.* – If any part or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act or any affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. *Repealing Clause.* – All existing laws or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

Section 5. *Effectivity Clause.* — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
